4 Boylan against Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket Number  
5 C-20065890. My name is Ky Van Nguyen. I am Administrative  
6 Law Judge presiding at this hearing. I will ask the parties

19 agreement.

20 MR. FARINAS: The terms of the agreement are  
21 as follows: As of this day, Mr. Boylan's account balance is  
22 one \$1,444.79. PGW will reduce this balance by \$544.79 to a  
23 combination of waiver of late payment charges and a credit  
24 to his accounts, which will result in a remaining account  
25 balance of \$900, which Mr. Boylan has agreed to pay \$100 a

1 month beginning July 2006.

2 JUDGE NGUYEN: Okay. Is that agreeable to  
3 you?

4 MR. BOYLAN: Yes, your Honor.

5 JUDGE NGUYEN: Okay. Thank you.

6 (Whereupon, at 10:04 a.m., the hearing was  
7 concluded.)
