INTERIM PAYMENT ORDER

The PECO Energy Company requested the Commission to issue an Interim Payment Order reminding the Complainant of her obligation to make regular monthly payments towards her PECO Energy Company utility bill while awaiting a hearing on the complaint, consistent with the Commission's Order in Charles Stammel v. PG Energy Company, A Division of Southern Union Company. Opinion and Order entered May 21, 2003 at Docket No. C-20027994.

The Complainant, Lyn D. Rezer is hereby directed to pay her monthly PECO Energy Company utility bills, on or before the billing due date, unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, until a final Commission Order is issued or until the proceeding is otherwise resolved.
