INTERIM PAYMENT ORDER

On June 12, 2002, at BCS No. 1107822, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services directed Danielle Johnson to pay her regular monthly budget amount, \$195, plus \$100 monthly on her overdue balance which was \$2,236.21 on April 24, 2002.

Ms. Johnson's budget payment has since declined to \$178, according to PECO's answer in this case. Also, her overdue balance has declined to \$2,080.44.

Based on a review of the parties' pleadings, Complainant Danielle Johnson is hereby directed to pay her regular monthly budget amount, \$178, plus \$100 each month on her overdue balance until otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge or a final Commission order.

Complainant Danielle Johnson is advised that, when this formal complaint is decided, she can be required to make a lump sum payment of any amount which she failed to pay in accordance with the Bureau's decision. Claypool v. T.W. Phillips Gas & Oil Co., Z-00248730 (order adopted November 9, 1995, entered December 22, 1995).


Dear Secretary McNulty:
