INTERIM PAYMENT ORDER



The Respondent utility, Philadelphia Gas Works, has requested the Commission to issue an Interim Payment Order reminding the Complainant of the obligation to make regular monthly payments towards the utility bill while awaiting a hearing on the complaint, consistent with the Commission's Order in Charles Stammel v. PG Energy Co., A Division of Southern Union Company, Opinion and Order entered May 21, 2003 at Docket No. C-20027994.

The Complainant, Lancine Diarassouba, is hereby directed to pay the monthly utility bill, on or before the billing due date, unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, until a final Commission Order is issued or until the proceeding is otherwise resolved.


Therefore the hearing scheduled for April 5, 2005 is no longer necessary.
