PREHEARING ORDER

An initial hearing in this case is scheduled for April 11, 2005 at 1:00 p.m. at the Philadelphia State Office Building, Broad and Spring Garden Streets, Philadelphia, PA 19130. Accordingly, the parties are hereby directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. You must serve me directly with a copy of any document that you file in this proceeding at the time of filing. If you send me any correspondence or document, you must send a copy to all other parties. A copy of the Commission's current service list of the parties to this proceeding is attached to this Order.

2. A request for a change of the scheduled initial hearing date must be submitted to me in writing no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing [52 Pa. Code §1.15(b)] and must be sent to me with copies to all parties of record. The correct address is 1302 State Office Building, Broad and Spring Garden Streets, Philadelphia, PA 19130. Such changes are granted only in rare situations where sufficient cause exists. Requests for changes of subsequent hearings, if any, should also be served on me with copies to all parties.

3. **YOU MAY LOSE THIS CASE IF YOU DO NOT TAKE PART IN THIS HEARING AND PRESENT EVIDENCE ON THE ISSUES RAISED.**

4. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must bring with you the required number of copies. This usually is four – the original and one copy for the Commission's records, one copy for me and one copy for every other party. Documents should be clearly marked for identification.

5. This hearing is a formal proceeding and will be conducted in accordance with the commission's rules of practice and procedure. Admissions contained in the pleadings may be offered at the hearing.

6. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§1.21 and 1.22, you may represent yourself, if you are an individual, or you may have an attorney represent you. However, if you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association or governmental agency or subdivision, you must have an attorney represent you in this proceeding. Unless you are a licensed attorney, you may not represent someone else.

7. The complainant bears the burden of proof in this proceeding and must show by a preponderance of the evidence that the respondent has violated the Public Utility Code or a regulation or an Order of this Commission so that the complainant is entitled to the relief requested in the Complaint.


8. If you intend to subpoena witnesses for the hearing, you should review the procedures established in 52 Pa. Code §5.421. You must submit your written application for subpoenas sufficiently in advance of the hearing so that the other parties will have the requisite ten days' notice to answer or object, and so that you will have enough time to receive the subpoena and serve it.

9. Any party may conduct discovery to learn the factual basis of another party's position in this case. However, 52 Pa. Code §5.331(b) provides, in relevant part, that "[p]articipants shall endeavor to initiate discovery as early in the proceedings as reasonably possible." Additionally, 52 Pa. Code §5.322 provides, in relevant part, that "participants are

encouraged to exchange information on an informal basis." All parties are urged to cooperate in informal information exchanges and in conducting discovery. Please note that there are limitations on discovery (52 Pa. Code §5.361) and sanctions for abuse of the discovery process. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.371 & 5.372.

10. Commission policy is to encourage settlements. 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a). Therefore, you are urged to discuss informally between yourselves the possible settlement of this case at least one week before the hearing. If you are unable to settle this case, you may still resolve as many questions or issues as possible during your informal discussion.






