INTERIM PAYMENT ORDER

The Respondent utility, Philadelphia Gas Works, has requested the Commission to issue an Interim Payment Order reminding the Complainant of the obligation to make regular monthly payments towards the utility bill while awaiting a hearing on the complaint, consistent with the Commission's Order in Charles Stammel v.
