SECOND INTERIM ORDER CONTINUING THE PROCEEDING

At the hearing held November 8, 2004 in this proceeding the parties reached a settlement and requested that this matter be continued for 30 days to give Ms. Hurd time to verify her income and thereby qualify for North Penn Gas Company's CAP program. When she is in the CAP program Ms. Hurd's monthly payments will decrease from \$119.00 to about \$82.00. In addition, Ms. Hurd will apply for the Dollar Energy Fund and LIHEAP. After Ms. Hurd qualifies for the CAP program, North Penn will submit a certificate of satisfaction, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24(b), and this proceeding will be closed by Secretarial Letter.


THEREFORE,

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That this proceeding is continued until December 8, 2004 to give Ms. Hurd time to verify her income and thereby qualify for North Penn Gas Company's CAP program, after which North Penn Gas Company will submit a certificate of satisfaction pursuant to 52 Pa. 


