

PPL Electric hereby certifies that the parties to the above-referenced Formal Complaint, now pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, have mutually and voluntarily agreed upon the following terms as full satisfaction of all outstanding legal and factual disputes in this proceeding, and Complainant has acknowledged satisfaction to PPL Electric:

(a) Complainant has agreed to pay a catch up amount of \$1,000.00 by July 31, 2002. Then, beginning with the August 16, 2002 due date, Complainant agrees to pay current budget bill of \$175.00 plus \$100.00 per month

towards the arrearage on Account No. 92730-18026 until paid in full. Complainant's overdue balance is \$3,768.66.

(b) PPL Electric agrees not to apply late payment charges to the amount of the arrearage at Account No. 92730-18026 for as long as the Complainant makes payments as stated in Paragraph 4(a).




