**Re: Agreement Between The Sewer Authority of the City of Scranton, the Lackawanna River Basin Sewer Authority, Siniawa Enterprises, and the Borough of Dickson City, Pennsylvania, dated June 14, 1989, (and related Assignment and Assumption Agreement By and Among The Sewer Authority of the City of Scranton, the Lackawanna River Basin Sewer Authority, the Borough of Dickson City, and Pennsylvania-American Water Company, dated October 17, 2016); EXPLANATION OF NON-FILING OF "EXHIBIT B" TO AGREEMENT; Docket No. U-2016-2581137**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am writing in response to an informal request by the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for a copy of "Exhibit B" to the above-referenced agreement (dated June 14, 1989). "Exhibit B" was a copy of uniform standards of The Sewer Authority of the City of Scranton ("SSA") for the acceptance for treatment and disposal by SSA of wastes other than sanitary sewage, as such standards existed in 1989 when the agreement was executed. Pennsylvania-American Water Company ("PAWC") is unable to obtain a copy of such standards. Moreover, the standards were modified several times since 1989.

As specified in Section 6 of the assignment and assumption agreement (dated October 17, 2016), PAWC's "Industrial Pretreatment Program and related tariff provisions" supplant "the rules and regulations of the SSA in effect at the time and on file with the other parties." As such, PAWC, in accordance with the assignment and assumption agreement, has not assumed the standards set forth in "Exhibit B" and "Exhibit B" is irrelevant to the instant filing under 66 Pa.C.S. § 507.
