INTERIM ORDER
SETTING RESOLUTION CONFERENCE

On or about March 24, 2004, Tonna Evans ("Complainant") filed a complaint against PECO Energy Company ("Respondent"), at the above-captioned Docket Number. To my knowledge, Respondent has not filed an answer to the complaint.

Based upon a review of the complaint, I direct the parties to attempt to resolve this matter themselves. Respondent shall contact Complainant no later than April 29, 2004, to set a mutually convenient time, date and place for Respondent and Complainant to hold a conference about resolving the case. The conference must take place no later than May 13, 2004, unless this is not possible.

Within ten (10) days following the conference, Respondent shall file a short report with Herbert R. Nurick, Mediator ("Mediator"), setting forth:

- (a) The time, date and place of the conference;
- (b) Who participated for each party;
- (c) A statement whether a full resolution, including withdrawal of complaint, was achieved, and, if not, whether the parties consent to have this case set for mediation by the mediation staff of the Commission; and
- (d) A statement of any issues which have been resolved, if a full resolution was not achieved.

The Commission encourages mediation if the parties cannot reach an agreement through the resolution conference. Mediation is an informal process in which the parties attempt to resolve the case with the help of a mediator. The mediator is a neutral staff member of the Commission who does not give advice, make a decision, or represent any party. Instead, the mediator assists the parties in their efforts to come to an agreement.

If the parties do not reach an agreement on their own, and do not consent to mediate, they are entitled to the hearing process. The hearing process usually includes the presentation of oral testimony and other evidence before a Commission administrative law judge, who will then consider the case and make a written decision to resolve it.

If it is not possible to have the conference by the date set for that purpose, Respondent shall file a report with the Mediator, on or before ten (10) days following the conference due date, giving the reason(s) why the due date could not be met.

In either situation, Respondent must file a report with the Mediator by the applicable due date set forth above.

ANSWER OF RESPONDENT PECO ENERGY COMPANY

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.61 responds to the Complaint and states:

1. Admitted.

2. Admitted.

3. Denied. PECO Energy admits that it estimated Complainant's usage at 323 Main Street, Delta, PA 17314. PECO Energy admits that a high bill investigation was conducted at 323 Main Street, Delta, PA 17314 and the meters for apartments B and C were replaced. PECO Energy denies that Complainant's billing is inaccurate. By way of further response, PECO Energy conducted a high bill field investigation on March 18, 2003. A meter reading was taken of both apartments B and C. An appliance analysis was conducted which confirmed Complainant's potential monthly usage in both units. A passing load test was conducted to the meters for apartments B and C, and the meter accuracy was verified. PECO Energy replaced the meters for apartments B and C to prevent estimated readings in the future. The removal readings of the existing meters showed that Complainant's usage was being overestimated. PECO Energy rebilled both accounts from January 31, 2003 to March 4, 2003.
