2 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE ROBERT P. MEEHAN: We'll go
3 on the Record.

4 This is the date set by the Pennsylvania Public
5 Utility Commission for hearing by telephone on the complaint
6 filed by Sergey R. Karamov against PECO Energy Company at
7 Docket No. C-20066841. I'm Robert Meehan, the
8 Administrative Law Judge assigned by the Commission to
9 preside over the matter and render an initial decision.

10 I'm now going to attempt to contact the complainant
11 at the number that he provided to my office in a phone call
12 on November 27th, which is area code (425) 373-6033.

13 MR. KARAMOV: Hello.

14 JUDGE MEEHAN: Good morning. Sergey Karamov?

15 MR. KARAMOV: Good morning, yes. Hi.

16 JUDGE MEEHAN: This is Judge Meehan with the
17 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

18 MR. KARAMOV: Hi.

19 JUDGE MEEHAN: Good morning. I'm going to
20 place you on hold while I call Mr. Swerling, the attorney
21 for PECO Energy Company, and then we'll be back with you, so
22 please stay on the line.

23 MR. KARAMOV: Actually we just talked and
24 there was settlement reached.

25 JUDGE MEEHAN: Really. Can you hold on while

1 I get him on the phone?

2 MR. KARAMOV: Okay.

3 JUDGE MEEHAN: Thank you.

4 MR. KARAMOV: Yes.

5 MR. SWERLING: Mike Swerling.

6 JUDGE MEEHAN: Good morning, Judge Meehan
7 calling.

8 MR. SWERLING: Good morning, Judge. How are
9 you?

10 JUDGE MEEHAN: I'm fine. I have Mr. Karamov
11 on the other line.

12 MR. SWERLING: Okay. We actually just settled
13 the case with Mr. Karamov, but we can put it on the Record
14 if you like.

15 JUDGE MEEHAN: Let me connect everybody up.
16 Okay. This is Judge Meehan and let me just make sure. Mr.
17 Karamov?

18 MR. KARAMOV: Uh-huh.

19 JUDGE MEEHAN: Mr. Swerling?

20 MR. SWERLING: Yes, Your Honor.

21 JUDGE MEEHAN: I want to tell you we are on
22 the Record and I do have each of you on a speaker phone here
23 in my office and there is also a Court Reporter present who
24 came to make a transcript of the hearing scheduled for this
25 morning.

1 My understanding from comments made by both Mr.
2 Karamov and Mr. Swerling is that the parties had an earlier
3 discussion today and have reached a settlement of this
4 dispute.

5 Am I correct on that?

6 MR. SWERLING: Yes, Your Honor.

7 JUDGE MEEHAN: All right.

8 MR. KARAMOV: Yes, that's correct.

9 JUDGE MEEHAN: Okay. Let me ask, Mr.

10 Swerling, will PECO Energy be filing with the Secretary's
11 office a Certificate of Satisfaction?

12 MR. SWERLING: Yes. I'll get that out this
13 morning, Your Honor.

14 JUDGE MEEHAN: All right. When that is sent
15 to the Secretary's office, please -- well, send me a copy,
16 but also send a copy to Stacey Nolan, who is the OALJ
17 Scheduling Officer for this case.

18 MR. SWERLING: N-o-l-a-n?

19 JUDGE MEEHAN: That is correct.

20 MR. SWERLING: Okay. Will do.

21 JUDGE MEEHAN: Thank you. Mr. Karamov, when
22 you receive that, you'll have a period of time, if you're
23 not happy, to write to the Commission Secretary and object
24 to the Certificate. Our regulations provide a 20-day period
25 in which to do that. But if you're happy with the agreement

1 you have made, when you get the letter from Mr.
2 Swerling, please do not write to the Secretary. Some time
3 in January or February of next year you'll each be getting a
4 letter which will tell you the Commission has marked this
5 case closed.

6 MR. KARAMOV: Uh-huh.

7 MR. SWERLING: Okay.

8 MR. KARAMOV: All right.

9 JUDGE MEEHAN: Okay. Well, I'm glad you were
10 able to work it out and thank everybody for being available
11 this morning.

12 MR. SWERLING: Thank you, Your Honor.

13 MR. KARAMOV: Thank you very much. Bye.

14 JUDGE MEEHAN: Bye.

15 (Thereupon, at 10:07 o'clock a.m., the Hearing
16 was adjourned).
