To Whom It May Concern:

By complaint received January 17, 2006, the complainant, Gary Bukky, advised the Commission that due to rough roadway conditions the at-grade crossing where Center Street, in the City of Corry, Erie County, crosses the tracks of the Western New York & Pennsylvania Railroad, LLC, has become hazardous to vehicular traffic.

A field conference and investigation was held on February 16, 2006, with representatives of Western New York & Pennsylvania Railroad, LLC, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, City of Corry and State Representative Sonney in attendance to discuss the issues.

A final inspection of the completed work was held at Center Street on July 14, 2006, with representatives of the Western New York & Pennsylvania Railroad, LLC, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, City of Corry and State Representative Sonney office in attendance.

Statements at that time indicated that the complainant, Gary Bukky, was experiencing difficulties of a nature that prohibited him from participating in a more active manner.


