PROTECTIVE ORDER

AND NOW, to wit, this 28th day of January, 2002, upon consideration of the Petition for Protective Order that Verizon North Inc. ("Verizon North") filed pursuant to Section 5.423 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code §5.423, the same having been served upon the parties and no response thereto having been filed, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Toll Traffic Study ("study") information that Verizon North will submit in this proceeding, as well as information relating to toll revenues and its capital costs, shall be marked and identified as proprietary information and sealed. Furthermore, to the extent the study and cost information are made part of the evidentiary record of this proceeding, they shall be filed separately from the public record.

2. Use of this proprietary information shall be restricted solely to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of reviewing

the study and cost information, and shall not be disclosed to any person other than Commission staff and counsel, and those persons herein identified.

3. No person other than Commission staff and counsel and those persons herein identified shall have access to this proprietary information without approval of the Commission, the presiding officer, or upon written agreement of Verizon North, nor shall any other person be informed of this proprietary information by any person having access thereto without approval of the Commission, the presiding officer, or upon written agreement of Verizon North.

4. No person shall review or examine or participate in the review or examination of this proprietary information until such person signs an agreement to comply with this Protective Order. A copy of such Agreement is attached hereto as Appendix 1 and made a part of this Order.

5. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.423(c), an officer, director, stockholder, partner, owner or employee of a competitor of Verizon North is not eligible to receive this proprietary information.


6. Complainants may use the proprietary information only for the purpose of preparing for or presenting testimony at the evidentiary hearings in this proceeding or for the purpose of preparing and presenting a brief, reply brief, exceptions or replies to exceptions in this proceeding. Furthermore, Complainants may disclose the proprietary information only to those persons directly employed or retained by the Complainants in connection with the preparation or presentation of their respective cases.

7. To the extent the parties, the presiding Administrative Law Judge or the Commission in any transcript, written advocacy, initial or final decision use this

proprietary information, the legend shall contain the designation of "CONTAINS CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPRIETARY INFORMATION" on the cover page of any transcript or written advocacy and on the first page of any initial or final decision. Documents so designated shall be sealed and filed separately from the public record.

8. The Commission shall maintain a list of all persons to whom this proprietary information is disclosed, and, for good cause shown, shall make the list available for inspection by counsel for Verizon North.

9. A copy of this Protective Order shall be served upon the parties and upon the Secretary's Bureau.


