PROCEEDINGS

2 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CYNTHIA W. FORDHAM: Good
3 afternoon. I am Administrative Law Judge Cynthia Williams Fordham and
4 this is the third of the Call of the Docket cases for this afternoon. The
5 name of the case is Ronald Majors versus Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket
6 No. C-20077294.

7 I note for the record the appearance of Ronald Majors, pro se, and
8 Laureto Farinas, Esquire, for Philadelphia Gas Works. Prior to going on the
9 record in this matter, the parties engaged in settlement negotiations and I
10 have been informed that they have reached a settlement. Mr. Farinas,
11 would you give us the terms of the settlement?

12 MR. FARINAS: Yes, Your Honor. The terms are as follows. The
13 current balance of Mr. Majors' account is \$6,398.26. This is comprised of
14 charges for gas in the amount of \$5,903.03, but also an amount for
15 charges of \$372.00 and a reconnection fee of \$123.23.

16 PGW has credited Mr. Majors' account in the amount of \$1,500.00
17 and he will also make a payment on or before June 3rd in the amount of
18 \$2,000.00. All of the credits and payments will result in a remaining
19 balance of \$2,898.26.

20 Mr. Majors has entered into a payment arrangement consisting of
21 payment of his current bill, plus \$81.00 a month on the remaining
22 outstanding balance for 36 months.

23 JUDGE FORDHAM: Mr. Majors, are you in agreement with the
24 terms outlined by Mr. Farinas?

25 MR. MAJORS: Yes.

1 JUDGE FORDHAM: Okay. Based on that, there is no need for me
2 to have a hearing in this matter. I want to thank the parties for engaging
3 in the settlement negotiations and agreeing to the terms that were outlined
4 earlier. Because of this, there will be no hearing and no decision written by
5 me. Mr. Farinas will file a Certificate of Satisfaction and the Commission
6 will mark this matter closed. Thank you very much.

7 MR. FARINAS: Thank you, Your Honor.

8 MR. MAJORS: Thank you.

9 JUDGE FORDHAM: You are welcome.

10 (Whereupon, at 2:10 p.m., the proceedings were concluded.)
