

TO: PECO ENERGY COMPANY

TAKE NOTICE:

That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,


1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, an answer (original and three copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated by the date at the top of this Notice. Section 1.56(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 1.56(a).

2. If you fail to either satisfy this complaint or to file answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, you will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this complaint in accordance with Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61. In that event, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

3. If you elect to satisfy this complaint you must file, within twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served, affidavits executed by each complainant that this complaint has been satisfied. Such affidavits must describe the basis on which this complaint was satisfied; any settlement agreement between the parties must be reduced to writing and attached to the affidavit. Such affidavits are to be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the address set forth in paragraph 1. Upon receipt of affidavits of satisfaction from all complainants, this complaint may be dismissed by the Commission in accordance with Section 703(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 703(a), unless the Commission determines that such dismissal would be contrary to the public interest, in which event the Commission may direct that hearings be held upon the complaint.

4. If you file an answer which admits the allegations in this complaint, or which fails to specifically deny the allegations in this complaint, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

5. If you file a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this complaint, or which raises material questions of law or fact, this matter shall be referred to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, you are found to have committed any of the violations alleged in the complaint, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. In the imposition of a penalty after a hearing the Administrative Law Judge is not bound by the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

ANSWER OF RESPONDENT PECO ENERGY COMPANY

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.61 responds to the Complaint and states:

- 1. Admitted.
- 2. Admitted.

1. Denied. PECO Energy denies that Complainant's bills are too high. By way of further response, PECO Energy discovered meter tampering at Complainant's property on February 26, 2003. On July 28, 2003, PECO Energy backbilled the Complainant from March 29, 1999 to February 26, 2003 in the amount of \$52,091.48. On September 11, 2004, Complainant's service was shut off for nonpayment. Complainant was required to pay a past due amount of \$3308.33, a \$250.00 reconnection fee and an \$874.00 deposit. Complainant made the required payment by check on the same day and service was restored between 5:27pm and 5:57 pm. On or around September 24, 2003, Complainant's restoration payment was returned for insufficient funds. On October 7, 2004, Complainant contacted PECO Energy to request a payment arrangement. PECO Energy informed the Complainant that she was not eligible for a payment arrangement. Complainant filed an informal complaint with the Bureau of Consumer Services on October 7, 2003 (No. 1507924). On October 8, 2003, Complainant filed for bankruptcy. PECO Energy set aside Complainant's account and provided Complainant with a post-petition account. On November 3, 2003, Complainant's bankruptcy was dismissed. On December 9, 2003, Complainant filed for bankruptcy again.

PECO Energy set aside Complainant's account again and provided Complainant with another post-petition account. On or around January 27, 2004, the informal complaint (No. 1507924) was verbally closed since the Complainant was a commercial ratepayer. A correct and accurate copy of the BCS Decision is attached as Exhibit A. In addition, the identified customer, Joyce Goodwin, notified the BCS that she did not initiate the Complaint and that she did not have any connection to 6108 Germantown Avenue or Walnut Hill Inn. On February 12, 2004 Complainant's bankruptcy was dismissed. On February 24, 2004, PECO Energy transferred the pre-petition balance to Complainant's current account. On March 5, 2004, Complainant filed another informal complaint with the Bureau of Consumer Services (No. 16604436). On or around March 17, 2004, the informal complaint was closed. From February 2003, Complainant never raised the allegation that her bills were too high or disputed the meter tampering.

PECO is, after reasonable investigation, without sufficient information to determine the truth of the remaining averments and they are therefore denied.

4. This paragraph is a request for relief and no answer is required.

WHEREFORE, PECO Energy Company respectfully requests that your Honorable Commission dismiss the instant Complaint.
