PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER **DOCKETED**

A telephonic prehearing conference in this case is scheduled for Friday, May 18, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. Accordingly, the parties are hereby directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. If you or any proposed witness will be at a telephone number that is different than the number on the notice for the prehearing conference, you must notify me of that telephone number at least one (1) week before the prehearing conference.

2. A request for a change of the scheduled prehearing conference date must be submitted in writing no later than five (5) days prior to the prehearing conference. 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b). Requests for changes of initial hearings must be sent to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge, 1103 Pittsburgh State Office Building, 300 Liberty Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15222. Only the undersigned Administrative Law Judge or OALJ Scheduling Staff may grant a request for a change of an initial hearing. Such changes are granted only in rare situations where sufficient cause exists. Requests for changes of subsequent prehearing conferences or hearings, if any, should also be served directly on me.

In accordance with the foregoing, absent a timely request for a continuance for good cause (i.e., no later than Friday, May 11, 2001), all parties must be prepared to participate in the scheduled prehearing conference.

3. Please review the regulation pertaining to prehearing conferences, 52 Pa. Code §5.222, and in particular, subsection (d) which provides, in part:

(d) Participants and counsel will be expected to attend the conference fully prepared for useful discussion of all problems involved in the proceeding, both procedural and substantive, and fully authorized to make commitments with respect thereto. The preparation should include, among other things, advance study of all relevant materials, and advance informal communication between the participants, including requests for additional data and information, to the extent it appears feasible and desirable. (Emphasis added.)

4. Each party must prepare and distribute a prehearing memorandum which sets forth the history of the proceeding, the issues you intend to present, and a listing of your proposed witnesses and the subject of their testimony.


5. Please review the regulations relating to discovery, specifically 52 Pa. Code §5.331(b), which provides, inter alia, that “[p]articipants shall endeavor to initiate discovery as early in the proceedings as reasonably possible,” and 52 Pa. Code §5.322, which encourages participants to exchange information on an informal basis. I urge all parties to cooperate in discovery. Such cooperation is preferable to numerous or protracted discovery disagreements, which require the presiding officer’s participation for resolution. Please be aware that there are limitations on discovery and sanctions for abuse of the discovery process. 52 Pa. Code §§5.361, 5.371-5.372.

6. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§1.21 & 1.22, you may represent yourself, if you are an individual, or you may have an attorney represent you. However, if you are a partnership,

corporation, trust, association or governmental agency or subdivision, you must have an attorney represent you in this proceeding. Unless you are an attorney, you may not represent someone else.

7. You must serve me directly with a copy of any document that you file in this proceeding. If you send me any correspondence or document, you must send a copy to all other parties. For your convenience, a copy of the Commission's current service list of the parties to this proceeding is enclosed with this Order.

FILED BY LINDA LESKO
AND MARY KASCHALK

Verizon North Inc. ("Verizon North"), by its counsel in this matter, Malatesta Hawke & McKeon LLP, hereby move to consolidate the complaints filed by Linda Lesko and Mary Kaschalk, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.81. In support thereof, Verizon North represents as follows:

BACKGROUND

1. On February 14, 2001, Linda Lesko filed a formal complaint against Verizon North with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in which she requested that the local calling area of Verizon North's Johnstown exchange be enlarged to provide toll-free calling to the Ebensburg exchange of Verizon Pennsylvania Inc. ("Verizon PA"). On March 7, 2001, Verizon North filed an answer to the formal complaint. On May 18, 2001, a prehearing conference was held in the above-captioned matter presided over by Administrative Law Judge John H. Corbett, Jr. At that time, the parties discussed, inter alia, scheduling.

2. On August 1, 2001, Mary Ann Kaschalk filed a formal complaint also requesting toll-free calling from Verizon North's Johnstown exchange to Verizon PA's Ebensburg exchange. On August 1, 2001 Verizon North filed a timely Answer to that complaint. The Commission has not yet scheduled a prehearing conference in Ms. Kaschalk's complaint. Therefore, if a presiding officer has been assigned, the respondent is unaware of that assignment.

3. The Commission's regulation at 52 Pa. Code §5.81 provides that complaints that include common issues of fact and law may be consolidated for purposes of hearing and decision.


4. It is abundantly clear, that the above-captioned complaints involve precisely the same subject matter. Consequently, the applicable law is identical as well.

5. Despite the fact that Ms. Lesko's complaint is procedurally several months ahead of the Kaschalk complaint, it is clear that consolidation of the complaints both in the interest of the parties as well as the public. Considerable time and expense can be saved if redundant

proceedings are avoided. Furthermore, consolidation would eliminate the prospect that Verizon North and Verizon PA might be confronted by differing decisions should the complaints be litigated separately.

WHEREFORE, Verizon North Inc. moves to consolidate the complaints of Linda Lesko and Mary Ann Kaschalk for purposes of hearing and decision.





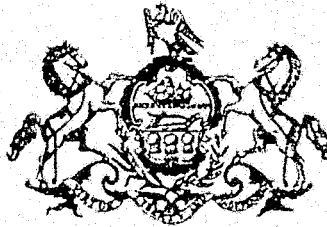
