HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On November 16, 2006, the undersigned received a Motion for Extension of Time Within Which to File Answer to Complaint from Respondent, Verizon Pennsylvania, Inc. In its Motion, Respondent avers that it has received two prior extensions of time and that its Answer to the Complaint is presently due on November 20, 2006.

Respondent further avers that to further settlement of this matter, it will perform certain work to address the Complaint allegations. Respondent requests a 90 day extension of time to file an answer to allow it to complete the required work and for Complainant to indicate her satisfaction with the work performed. Respondent submits that the granting of a further extension of time will contribute to the settlement of this case and is thus, in the public interest.

In light of the ongoing settlement discussions between Complainant and Respondent and Respondent's agreement to perform certain work in an attempt to resolve the Complaint, I conclude that this request for extension of time is reasonable. Accordingly, Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time Within Which to File Answer to Complaint is

granted. If settlement of this proceeding is not achieved, Respondent's Answer to the Complaint shall be filed no later than March 1, 2007.


THEREFORE,






