I,:Joseph: of the :Fuce:-Family, in the second generation, Sovereign, Sui juris, in the jurisdiction of the State and National Flag, do not agree with any part of the Initial Decision based on the fraudulent actions of :Angela-T.:Jones: and :Laureto-A.:Farinas:,:Esquire. For the exceptions are as follows:

1. For the Initial Decision incited by :Angela-T: of the :Jones:-Family, is written in improper-English which is a fictitious-conveyance-of-language, a falsehood, and perjury in direct violation of Pennsylvania Code Title 18, Section 4904 and therefore the Initial Decision is null and void. :Angela-T.:Jones: on the eighteenth day of the month of June, 1992, knowingly, willfully, and on her own volition took a verbal oath of Office solemnly swearing, that, she would "discharge the duties of her office with fidelity".

:Angela-T.:Jones: acting under color of law, knowingly and willfully, accepted an unsworn answer from :Laureto-A.:Farinas:,:Esquire the representative of the private company known as Philadelphia Gas works. Enclosed, the Commission will find a notarized copy of the Oath of Office taken by :Angela-T.:Jone:.

2. On the Twenty-third day of the month of November, 1987, :Laureto-Aldamo: of the :Farinas:-Family, knowingly and willfully, solemnly swore, that, he would "discharge the duties of his office with fidelity". On the Seventeenth day of the month of October, 2006, :Laureto-A.: of the :Farinas:-Family, Esquire, acting under the color of law, knowingly, willfully, and in direct violation of his Oath of Office incited and filed an un-notarized verification which

is written in improper-English which is a fictitious-conveyance-of-language, a falsehood, and perjury in direct violation of his Oath of Office and a direct violation of the Pennsylvania Code Title 18, Section 4904 and therefore :Laureto A.:Farinas: presented no evidence in the record that substantiates the Philadelphia Gas Works claim, that, P.G.W. did not breach the CRP agreement. For the Complaint

For the witness is with the volition of the truth with his testimony.

I, :Joseph: of the :Fuce:-Family, in the second generation, Sovereign, of the State of Pennsylvania, County of Philadelphia, am the complainant. I, :Joseph: reserve my right not to be compelled to assent to any contract or commercial agreement, that, I, :Joseph: did not enter knowingly, voluntarily, and intentionally. I, :Joseph: do not accept the liability of the compelled benefit of any unrevealed contract or commercial agreement with the Philadelphia Gas Works, a private company. For the only agreement between the P.G.W., a private company and I, :Joseph: was the Customer Responsibility Program [CRP] agreement valued at \$57.54. P.G.W. violated the CPR agreement by increasing the value of the agreement to \$95.53 without proper notification, in writing, prior to billing us.

For the Facts

1. On the Fifteenth day of the month of March, 2006, the P.G.W. forwarded to my residence a recertification reminder notice concerning the CRP agreement. EXHIBIT-A
2. On the Twenty-second day of the month of March, 2006, my wife, :Karen: and I, applied to re-certify the CPR agreement valued at \$57.54 and reserved our rights "without prejudice" pursuant to Uniform Commercial Code [U.C.C.], Section 1-207 to be properly notified, in writing, concerning any increase to the value of the CPR agreement entered into by both parties, prior, to the billing of the annual re-certification agreement. EXHIBIT-B, pages 1-5
3. On the Twentieth day of the month of April, 2006, P.G.W., "without proper

notification", in writing, forwarded a bill showing the CRP agreement increased to the value of \$95.53.

4. On the Twenty-first day of the month of April, 2006, I, :Joseph: forwarded a complaint concerning the CRP agreement to P.G.W.. EXHIBIT-C
5. On the Fifth day of the month of May, 2006, :George: of the :villano: -Family, a representative for the dispute resolution unit of the P.G.W. forwarded to my residence a letter stating, "Your inquiry has been recieved and forwarded to the proper department for corrective action." EXHIBIT-D
6. On the First day of the month of September, 2006, I, :Joseph: filed a formal complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission[P.U.C.] complaining, that, P.G.W. increase the value of the CRP agreement without proper notification and therefore breached the agreement entered into by both parties. EXHIBIT-E
7. On the Seventeenth day of the month of October, 2006, :Laureto-A.: of the :Farinas:-Family, Esquire#50415, the legal representative for P.G.W., acting under color of law, knowingly, willfully, made a verification subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S., Section 4904, that, P.G.W. denied breaching the CRP agreement. For the Laws

Jurisdiction

Pa.C.S., Title 66, Part I, Subpart B, Chapter 5, Section 502:

Whenever the Commission[P.U.C.] shall be of the opinion, that, any corporation, is violating, any provisions of this part, or neglected to perform any duty enjoined upon it by this part, or has neglected or refused to obey any lawful requirement, or regulation made by the Commission; then and in every such case the Commission may institute the appropriate legal proceedings, to restrain such violations of mission, and to enforce obedience thereto.

Violation

Pa.C.S., Title 52, Part I, Subpart A, Chapter 56, Subpart F, Section 56.151(3):
Upon initiation of a dispute covered by this section, the utility shall:
Make a diligent attempt to negotiate a reasonable agreement if the occupant
claims an inability to pay....

Remedy

Uniform Commercial Code, Article 1, Part 2, Sections 1-207(1) & 1-207.7:
A party who with explicit reservation of rights assents to performance in a
manner demanded by the other party does not thereby prejudice the rights
reserved. The making of a valid reservation of rights preserves whatever
rights the person then possesses, and prevents the loss of such rights by ap-
plication of concepts of waiver or estoppel.

Recourse

Uniform Commercial Code, Article 1, Part 2, Section 1-103.6:
The Code [U.C.C.] is complimentary to the common law, which remains in force,
except where displaced by the code. A statute should be construed in harmony
with the common law, unless there is a clear legislative intent to abrogate the
Common law.

Pa.C.S., Title 66, Part I, Subpart E, Chapter 33, Section 3315:
Disposition of fines and penalties.

For the Conclusion of the Facts and laws

9. I, :Joseph: of the :Fuce:-Family, in the second generation, Sovereign, and the Philadelphia Gas works, a private company are bound by the CRP agreement entered into on the twenty-second day of the month of march, 2006.
10. On the Twentieth day of the month of April, 2006, without proper notification, P.G.W. increased the value of the CRP agreement.
11. On the Seventeenth day of the month of October, 2006, :Laureto-A.: of the :Farinas:-Family, Esquire#50415, the legal representative for P.G.W., acting under color of law, knowingly and willfully, verified, that, P.G.W. denied breaching the CRP agreement, but neglected to provide evidence of the notification of the increase prior to the billing concerning the re-certification agreement and therefore is estopped from producing further evidence. P.G.W. and :Laureto-A.: :Farinas:, Esquire#50415 remained silent concerning the settlement of the

P.U.C.

complaint filed by me, :Joseph: of the :Face:-Family, in the second generation, Sovereign, the complaintant.

For the relief

12. 




