P-R O C E E D I N G S

Administrative Law Judge: Ky Van Nguyen.

Good morning, we open the record for a hearing on the complaining of Heriberto Cosme against Philadelphia Gas Works at docket number C-20066951. My name is Ky Van Nguyen. I am administrative law judge presiding at this hearing. I would ask the parties to identify themselves for the record.

Mr. Cosme, can you identify yourself for the record, please.

MR. COSME: I am Heriberto Cosme.

JUDGE NGUYEN: Where do you reside?

MR. COSME: 309 W. Wyoming Avenue.

MR. FARINAS: Good morning, your Honor. Laureto Farinas counsel for Philadelphia Gas Works.

JUDGE NGUYEN: You have reached an agreement with Mr. Cosme?

MR. FARINAS: Yes. Mr. Cosme has graciously agreed to settle this matter with PGW.

JUDGE NGUYEN: How about the terms.

MR. FARINAS: The terms of this settlement are as follows.

JUDGE NGUYEN: The current balance of Mr. Cosme's account is \$3310.32. PGW will waive late

1 payment charges in the amount of \$140.50. We'll put
2 additional credit on the account in the amount of \$300
3 for a total reduction in the balance of 440.50. The
4 reduction will lead to a new balance of \$2869.82.

5 Mr. Cosme has agreed to make payments in
6 the amount of \$80 per month for a period of 36 months
7 to begin with in February of 2007, February 28th. As
8 there is no longer a service in Mr. Cosme's name at
9 the service address, there is no other additional
10 amounts to be paid on the account except for the \$80
11 per month.

12 JUDGE NGUYEN: I will ask, Mr. Cosme, are
13 you agreeable to that?

14 MR. COSME: Yes, sir.

15 JUDGE NGUYEN: Thank you.

16 MR. FARINAS: Your Honor, I will file a
17 certificate of satisfaction this afternoon. I'll fax
18 it to you and also send not only the Certificate of
19 Satisfaction but also a letter reducing those terms to
20 writing so that you'll have them in writing.

21 JUDGE NGUYEN: Thank you. You can go
22 home now.
