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DISCUSSION AMONG PARTIES

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P R O C E E D I N G S

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3 JUDGE ANGELA JONES:

4 We're on the record. This is the time
5 and place for the telephonic hearing of Anthony
6 Cristiano versus Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket
7 Number C-20077830. I am Administrative Law Judge
8 Angela T. Jones, appointed by the Commission to
9 preside over this matter. As I said earlier, this is
10 a telephonic hearing. I do have a court reporter
11 physically with me. Appearing telephonically are Mr.
12 and Mrs. Cristiano, Mr. Anthony Cristiano. And Mrs.
13 Cristiano. What is your first name, ma'am?

14 MRS. CRISTIANO:

15 Jean.

16 JUDGE JONES:

17 I'm sorry. Could you spell that?

18 MRS. CRISTIANO:

19 J-E-A-N, Jean.

20 JUDGE JONES:

21 Oh, J-E-A-N.

22 MRS. CRISTIANO:

23 That's right.

24 JUDGE JONES:

25 Thank you. And for --- appearing for PGW

1 is Mr. Laureto Farinas, Esquire accompanied by two
2 witness for the company. Mr. Farinas has reported
3 that the Cristiano's have settled their dispute with
4 PGW. And Mr. Farinas, I will allow you to be the
5 spokesperson to provide the terms on the record, sir.

6 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

7 Yes. Thank you, Your Honor. As I
8 mentioned and as you mentioned, the Cristianos have
9 graciously agreed to settle this matter with PGW. The
10 terms of the settlement are that PGW will have the
11 Cristiano's pavement, three blocks of the pavement,
12 plus some of the curbwork repaved and repaired.

13 JUDGE JONES:

14 Mr. and Mrs. Cristiano, you have heard
15 Mr. Farinas' recitation of a summary of your
16 negotiations for settlement. Are they accurate to
17 your best --- the best of your beliefs?

18 MR. CRISTIANO:

19 Just one thing I want to add, Your Honor.
20 The curbing also has to be repaired.

21 JUDGE JONES:

22 I believe he did say the curbing.

23 MR. CRISTIANO:

24 Okay. Fine.

25 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

1 And by the way, Your Honor, we did agree
2 to do this within the next two weeks. I'm sorry.
3 After two --- after the ten-day period has run.

4 JUDGE JONES:

5 Okay.

6 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

7 Okay?

8 JUDGE JONES:

9 All right. Mr. Cristiano, you have heard
10 the supplemental terms of the settlement. Do you have
11 anything to add, any correction or modifications?

12 MR. CRISTIANO:

13 No, Your Honor.

14 JUDGE JONES:

15 Okay. And are they accurate to the best
16 of your belief, sir?

17 MR. CRISTIANO:

18 Yes, they are.

19 JUDGE JONES:

20 Very well. I believe based on the terms
21 that Mr. Farinas has provided to you, he has told you
22 that you will be receiving a document in writing
23 basically providing the terms that you have agreed to
24 orally in writing as well as notice that if you should
25 decide that these terms are accurate that you don't

1 need to do nothing --- do anything and the Commission
2 will report that this matter is closed. However, once
3 you should receive the document in writing and you
4 should have a change of heart or they are inaccurate,
5 you have ten days to inform the company as well as the
6 Commission. If we do not hear from you within the
7 ten-day period, the Commission will act as if the
8 matter is settled and closed. I believe that is why
9 the ten-day period is in your terms before PGW will
10 start repaving your block, three blocks and your
11 curbs; is that correct, Mr. Cristiano?

12 MR. CRISTIANO:

13 That's fine, Your Honor.

14 MRS. CRISTIANO:

15 Tens days then is ---?

16 JUDGE JONES:

17 It's ten days from the date that you will
18 see on your paper, ma'am.

19 MRS. CRISTIANO:

20 Okay. Okay.

21 JUDGE JONES:

22 Do you understand that?

23 MRS. CRISTIANO:

24 Yes.

25 JUDGE JONES:

1 Mr Farinas, did I outline those terms
2 accurately, sir?

3 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

4 Yes, you did, Your Honor.

5 JUDGE JONES:

6 Is there anything else that the parties
7 wish to bring before me today?

8 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

9 Nothing further, Your Honor.

10 MR. CRISTIANO:

11 Nothing from us either.

12 JUDGE JONES:

13 Very well. Thank you, Mr. and Mrs.

14 Cristiano. Thank you, Mr. Farinas. We are adjourned.

15 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

16 Thank you.

17 MR. CRISTIANO:

18 Thank you, Judge.

19 MRS. CRISTIANO:

20 Thank you very much.

21 JUDGE JONES:

22 Bye.

23 MRS. CRISTIANO:


