PREHEARING ORDER

An Initial Telephonic Hearing in this case is scheduled for **Wednesday, March 30, 2005, at 3:00 pm.** Your case is one of several that are scheduled for this day. **You must be available when contacted by the presiding officer or your case will be dismissed. If you will be at a telephone number that is different than the number listed on the Complaint, you must notify me of that telephone number at least five (5) business days before the hearing.**

The parties are directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. A request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must state the agreement or opposition of other parties, and must be submitted in writing no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). Requests for changes of initial hearings must be sent to me with copies to all parties of record. The correct address is: Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell, Office of Administrative Law Judge, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg PA 17105-3265.

Changes are granted only in rare situations where sufficient cause exists.

2. Commission policy promotes settlements. 52 Pa. Code § 5.231(a). The utility is directed to contact the Complainant at least one week before the scheduled hearing to talk over a possible settlement of this case. Even if you are unable to settle this case, you may still resolve as many questions or issues as possible during your talks. If an agreement is reached, a

formal hearing will not be necessary and the scheduled hearing will be canceled. Complainant is advised that a new law has been passed which severely limits the ability of the Commission to impose payment arrangements on regulated utilities.

3. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits for my consideration, you must send one copy to the other party and three (3) copies to me at least five (5) business days before the hearing. Proposed exhibits should be properly pre-marked for identification purposes.

4. Although the hearing is being conducted telephonically for the convenience of the parties, it is still a formal proceeding and will be conducted in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedures. 52 Pa. Code, Chapters 1, 3 and 5.

5. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.21 & 1.22, you may represent yourself if you are an individual, or you may have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or admitted pro hac vice represent you. However, if you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, you must have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania represent you in this proceeding. Unless you are an attorney, you may not represent someone else. Attorneys shall ensure that their appearances are entered in accordance with the provisions of 52 Pa. Code § 1.25(b).

6. If you intend to subpoena witnesses for the hearing, you should review the procedures established in 52 Pa. Code § 5.421. You must submit your written application to me sufficiently in advance of the hearing date so that the other party will have the required ten (10) days' notice to answer or object, and so that you will have enough time to receive the subpoena and serve it.


7. COMPLAINANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT OF BILLS FOR USAGE INCURRED PENDING THE RESOLUTION OF THIS COMPLAINT. FAILURE TO MAINTAIN PAYMENTS MAY RESULT IN THE TERMINATION OF UTILITY SERVICE. IN ADDITION, PAYMENT OF ALL UNPAID BILLS IN ONE LUMP SUM COULD BE REQUIRED UPON RESOLUTION OF THE COMPLAINT.

8. THIS CASE WILL BE DISMISSED IF YOU FAIL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING AND PRESENT EVIDENCE ON THE ISSUES RAISED.

9. The Complainant bears the burden of proving the case and must demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that he is entitled to the relief requested in the Complaint. Complainant should be prepared to support his claims with documentation and/or with specific dates of events which could have an impact on the claims. Three copies of budget information forms are included. Complainant should fill these out and keep one copy for personal use during the hearing. One copy must be sent to me, and the remaining copy must be sent to the utility's counsel.

10. Utility must prepare and submit an account history for the customer for the period of time covering the Complaint, or at least eighteen months, whichever is longer.


