



TO: EQUITABLE GAS COMPANY

TAKE NOTICE:

That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,

1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, an answer (original and two copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated by the date at the top of this Notice. Section 1.56(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 1.56(a).


2. If you fail to either satisfy this complaint or to file answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, you will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this complaint in accordance with Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61. In that event, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which

prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

3. If you elect to satisfy this complaint you must file, within twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served, affidavits executed by each complainant that this complaint has been satisfied. Such affidavits must describe the basis on which this complaint was satisfied; any settlement agreement between the parties must be reduced to writing and attached to the affidavit. Such affidavits are to be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the address set forth in paragraph 1. Upon receipt of affidavits of satisfaction from all complainants, this complaint may be dismissed by the Commission in accordance with Section 703(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 703(a), unless the Commission determines that such dismissal would be contrary to the public interest, in which event the Commission may direct that hearings be held upon the complaint.

4. If you file an answer which admits the allegations in this complaint, or which fails to specifically deny the allegations in this complaint, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

5. If you file a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this complaint, or which raises material questions of law or fact, this matter shall be referred to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, you are found to have committed any of the violations alleged in the complaint, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. In the imposition of a penalty after a hearing the Administrative Law Judge is not bound by the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

called to have service started in his name at the subject address. Mr. Houston was advised that he would have to pay a \$320.00 deposit for service based on his credit score. On August 29, 2003 Jennifer Cheddar called for service at the subject address. Jennifer was advised to pay a \$312.00 deposit based on her credit score. On September 2, 2003 Jesse Houston paid one-half of the required security deposit and gas service was placed into his name on September 3, 2003. On July 2, 2004 the Complainant called and identified himself as a roommate of the ratepayer and scheduled a final reading for July 6, 2004. The Complainant stated that he shared the premises with the ratepayer of record and everyone else had moved out. On July 6, 2004 the Complainant called to reschedule the final reading to July 7, 2004 because no one was home for the July 6, 2004 reading. On July 14, 2004 the Complainant called to discuss the amount of the final bill. The call center representative refused to discuss the bill with the Complainant because he was not the ratepayer of record.

The averments of Paragraph 4 of the Complaint contain a prayer for relief to which no response is required. To the extent that a response is deemed necessary, Equitable is filing under separate cover a Motion to Dismiss the instant Complaint. Collection action will begin against the ratepayer of record and not the Complainant. The ratepayer of record paid a deposit of \$312.00, which has accrued \$4.95 interest, and which will be applied toward the \$783.48 balance, bringing the final balance to \$466.53. There has been no request by anyone to re-establish service at this address.

The Complainant has been quite abusive to Equitable's employees (see the attached e-mail correspondence) and our employees have been instructed to have no further contact with him. Actually, however, he is correct insofar as he is not the proper party to seek payment for the final bill. The account is in the name of Jesse Houston and he is the party to be held initially responsible. If Mr. Houston had some arrangement with his roommates for payment of utilities, that is an issue for them to resolve. Any complaint concerning the final bill, however, must be initiated by Mr. Houston.

WHEREFORE, the Respondent, Equitable Gas Company, respectfully requests that the subject Complaint be dismissed.






4. Complainant has failed to provide any documentation or other evidentiary support, or even make factual allegations, to substantiate his entitlement to file a Complaint on behalf of the ratepayer of record. Accordingly, the Complainant has no standing to bring a complaint on behalf of Jesse C. Houston. Additionally, the account has been finalized at the request of the Complainant. There is no request for re-establishment of service under the Complainant's name.

5. If Complainant's claim and/or Complaint is based solely upon the rights and liabilities established by the service agreement with the ratepayer of record, then Complainant has no standing to proceed in this manner as he does not have a direct and immediate interest in the proceedings as mandated by law (77 P.S. § 701)

6. Finally, the Complainant failed to allege the violation of any law or regulation relating to the Public Utility Code and/or the regulations, and merely questions the amount of the final bill. The meter for this account was located inside the residence and required the ratepayer's assistance in having it read. On three occasions in the previous ten months Equitable attempted to get an actual reading but was unsuccessful as the ratepayer was not at home. Accordingly, bills for usage appear to have been estimated at too low a usage amount during the winter, resulting in a final reading that is higher than the Complainant thinks is appropriate. Estimated reads are not in violation of any law, regulation or Equitable's tariff. If the account had not been finalized, Equitable would have advised the ratepayer in August that an actual reading is necessary or service would be interrupted until access to the premises could be obtained.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Equitable respectfully requests that this Motion to Dismiss be granted and that the Complaint be dismissed with prejudice.




