2 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE HERBERT SMOLEN: This is the
3 matter of Tonya Miller versus Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket
4 C-20065774. My name is Herbert Smolen and I am the Administrative Law
5 Judge assigned by the Commission to hear the evidence in this case and to
6 render an initial decision in writing in due course.
