Dear Judge Vero:

I am in receipt of Complainant's Petition to Withdraw the above-referenced formal complaint filed with the Commission on December 5, 2016. Please be advised that PECO objects to the Complainant's request to withdraw the complaint.

The Complainant currently has an outstanding balance of \$3,462.11 with PECO and has filed four informal complaints and the current formal complaint to obtain a payment agreement on past due balance. Your Honor continued the Wednesday, November 9, 2016, hearing to give the Complainant an opportunity to submit a Customer Assistance Program (CAP) application by November 16, 2016. To date, the Complainant has not submitted a CAP application. Without enrollment in CAP or an Initial Decision, the balance will not be resolved, which will precipitate additional informal and formal complaints.

In light of the above and the prejudice it is causing to PECO, the company requests that this matter be scheduled for hearing on Judge Guhl's January 9, 2016, Call of the Docket or Judge Heep's February 2, 2016, Call of the Docket.
