MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Tuesday, January 24, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Complainant alleges in his formal complaint that PECO caused his tanning salon to lose customers after PECO responded to two hot meter socket alarms.
3. The Complainant specifically alleges that PECO's technician told his customers there would be a fire and they should leave the building.
4. At the hearing, PECO will present the testimony of Technician, Michael Mignola who was at the Complainant's premises that day.
5. PECO will also present the testimony of Technician, Matthew Maginnis who was at the Complainant's premises that day.
6. Mr. Mignola is ill and has lost his voice. He is barely able to speak above a whisper.
7. Mr. Maginnis has a prescheduled vacation day and will be out of the state on Tuesday.

8. Both Mr. Mignola and Mr. Maginnis are unavailable Tuesday, January 24th due to illness and a prescheduled vacation day.

9. The testimony of these two technicians is critical to PECO's defense, particularly as the Complainant alleges they told his customers to leave the building because of a fire.

10. PECO has been in communication with the Complainant, Mr. Baker and PECO advised him that the company requires additional time to find a resolution to his issues. PECO believes that with additional time, there may be resolution to this case.

11. Mr. Baker advised that he would like to proceed to hearing on the scheduled hearing date – Tuesday, January 24th.

12. As two PECO witnesses are not available for the January 24th hearing and the company requires additional time to attempt resolution of Mr. Baker's complaint, PECO respectfully requests a continuance of this matter.

13. PECO Energy respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
