P R O C E E D I N G S

JUDGE CHARLES RAINEY:

Good morning. My name is Charles Rainey and I am the Administrative Law Judge who has been assigned to this case. And this is the case of Shirley Stevenson versus Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket Number C-20077604. I note the appearances by telephone of Shirley Stevenson, who is appearing pro se or in her own behalf, and also the appearance of Laureto Farinas, Esquire on behalf of Philadelphia Gas Works.

The parties engaged in settlement discussions prior to our going on the record and it's my understanding that they have arrived at a settlement. At this time I'll ask Mr. Farinas to provide the terms of the settlement for the record.

ATTORNEY FARINES:

Yes, Your Honor. The terms of the settlement are as follows. The balance from Ms. Stevenson's PGW account is \$6,778.23. PGW will waive late payment charges that have accumulated on the account in the amount of \$961.26. This results in a remaining outstanding balance of \$5,816.97. Ms. Stevenson has agreed to enter a payment arrangement

1 consisting of a payment of \$241 a month for 60 months.
2 This is in two parts. One is a budget portion of \$144
3 plus \$97 towards the arrears until paid in full. Ms.
4 Stevenson has been apprised of the fact that the
5 budget plan amount is reviewed several times a year
6 and is subject to change depending upon her usage
7 pattern.

8 JUDGE RAINEY:

9 Thank you, Mr. Farinas. Ms. Stevenson,
10 have you heard the terms of the settlement as stated
11 by Mr. Farinas?

12 MS. STEVENSON:

13 Yes.

14 JUDGE RAINEY:

15 And are you in agreement with those
16 terms?

17 MS. STEVENSON:

18 Yes.

19 JUDGE RAINEY:

20 Okay. I am then going to direct Mr.
21 Farinas to file a Certificate of Satisfaction within
22 five days from today. And Ms. Stevenson, with the
23 filing of that Certificate of Satisfaction, you will
24 have five days from the date of the filing in order to
25 file a written objection. If you do not file a

1 written objection to this Certificate of
2 Satisfaction - - .

3 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

4 I'm sorry. Did you say five days?

5 JUDGE RAINEY:

6 I'm sorry. Ten days. You'll have ten
7 days, I'm sorry. You'll have ten days from the date
8 of the Certificate of Satisfaction to file any written
9 objections to the Certificate of Satisfaction. Ms.
10 Stevenson, if you do not file any written objections
11 to the Certificate of Satisfaction, then the case will
12 proceed to close. Do you have any questions, Ms.
13 Stevenson?

14 MS. STEVENSON:

15 No.

16 JUDGE RAINEY:

17 Okay. Very good. I would like to thank
18 the parties for arriving at an amicable settlement of
19 this case. And if there is nothing further, then this
20 hearing is adjourned. Thank you very much and have a
21 good day.


