3 JUDGE CYNTHIA W. FORDHAM:

4 Good afternoon. I'm Administrative Law  
5 Judge Cynthia Williams Fordham and this is the time  
6 and place for the hearing in the matter of Patrick J.  
7 Ianieri versus PECO Energy Company at Docket Number  
8 C-20065807. I note for the record the appearance of  
9 Lisa Lutz, Esquire, for PECO Energy Company and  
10 Patrick J. Ianieri, pro Se.

11 Prior to going on the record in this  
12 case, the parties engaged in settlement negotiations  
13 and I believe they have reached a settlement. Ms.  
14 Lutz, would you like to put the settlement on the  
15 record?

16 ATTORNEY LUTZ:

17 Yes, Your Honor. The parties have  
18 reached a settlement wherein the Complainant will pay  
19 \$461 by May 27, and then beginning with his bill due  
20 in June, he agrees to pay the current charges, plus  
21 \$170 a month towards the account arrears. And I will  
22 within five business days file a letter of  
23 satisfaction on this case.

25 Thank you. Mr. Ianieri, the terms that

1 Ms. Lutz just recited, are you in agreement with those  
2 terms?

3 MR. IANIERI:

4 Yes, I am, Your Honor.

5 JUDGE FORDHAM:

6 Okay. Since the parties have reached a  
7 settlement there's no reason to have testimony in this  
8 matter; therefore, the hearing will not be held in  
9 terms of testimony and I will not have to write a  
10 decision. Ms. Lutz indicated that she will file a  
11 certificate of satisfaction. That will be processed  
12 through the Commission and your case will be marked  
13 closed. Thank you very much.
