PREHEARING ORDER #3

As a result of the prehearing conference conducted on January 6, 2017, I issued Prehearing Order #2, dated January 6, 2017. Prehearing Order #2 established a litigation and briefing schedule based on the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (Commission's) December 22, 2016 order and subsequent errata notice suspending PPL's filings until July 1, 2017.

By opinion and order dated January 19, 2017 the Commission modified its December 22, 2016 order and suspended PPL's filings until October 1, 2017. I conducted a further prehearing conference on January 20, 2017 in order to revise the litigation and briefing schedule in light of the Commission's January 19, 2017 opinion and order.

At the January 20, 2017 prehearing conference, the parties agreed to a revised litigation and briefing schedule. This order adopts that agreed upon litigation and briefing schedule. The order also modifies certain discovery provisions.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That paragraph 3 of Prehearing Order #2, dated January 6, 2017, is modified to read as follows:

That the following schedule is adopted:

Prehearing conference	January 6, 2017
Further prehearing conference	January 20, 2017
Prepared direct	February 22, 2017
Prepared rebuttal	March 24, 2017
Prepared surrebuttal	April 7, 2017
Evidentiary hearings in Harrisburg	April 18, 20-21, 2017
Main briefs	May 19, 2017
Reply briefs	June 9, 2017
Close of evidentiary record	June 9, 2017

3. That paragraph 7 of Prehearing Order #3, dated January 6, 2017, is modified to read as follows:

That the parties have agreed to modify the Commission's normal discovery timelines as follows:

- a. The Parties shall make best efforts to serve answers to written interrogatories within ten (10) calendar days of service.
- b. The Parties shall make best efforts to serve responses to requests for document production, entry for inspection, or other purposes in-hand within ten (10) calendar days.
- c. The Parties shall make best efforts to serve responses to requests for admission in-hand within ten (10) calendar days.
- d. Discovery and discovery-related pleadings propounded after 12:00 noon on a Friday or after 12:00 noon on any business day immediately preceding a state holiday will be deemed served on the next business day for purposes of determining the due date of the responses and responsive pleadings.

e. Objections to interrogatories shall be communicated orally within three (3) calendar days of service of the interrogatories; unresolved objections shall be served to the ALJ in writing within five (5) days of service of the interrogatories. Objections to interrogatories served on a Friday shall be communicated orally within four (4) calendar days, and unresolved objections shall be served to the ALJ in writing within six (6) days of service of the interrogatories.

f. Motions to dismiss objections and/or direct the answering of interrogatories shall be filed within three (3) calendar days of service of the written objections.

g. Answers to motions to dismiss objections and/or direct the answering of interrogatories shall be filed within three (3) calendar days of service of such motions.

3. That except as modified in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, Prehearing Order #2, dated January 6, 2017, shall remain in full force and effect.
