INTERIM PAYMENT ORDER



On or about February 25, 2002, the Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services (BCS) directed Tawnia Sullivan to make a Customer Assistance Program (CAP) catch-up payment in the amount of \$200.00. Pursuant to Section 56174(3) of the Commission's regulations (pertaining to stays and payment orders) Duquesne Light Company has requested the issuance of an interim payment order directing Tawnia Sullivan to make the catch-up payment as directed by the BCS until the Commission's Order is entered in this case, or the case is otherwise resolved.

Based upon a review of the pleadings, the Complainant is directed to pay, on or before August 12, 2002, the CAP catch-up payment in the amount of \$200.00 and to pay the CAP payment each month and continue to make monthly CAP payments until such time as a different payment arrangement may be established in this case.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER MAY RESULT IN THE TERMINATION OF TAWNIA SULLIVAN'S SERVICE. DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY MUST GIVE TERMINATION NOTICES AS REQUIRED BY 52 PA. CODE, CHAPTER 56.
