ORDER GRANTING REQUEST
FOR CONTINUANCE

By Hearing Notice dated December 9, 2005, a hearing was scheduled in this matter for February 22, 2006. By letter received by me on February 16, 2006, complainant Darlene Servance requested that the hearing be continued and rescheduled because "one of my duties in my capacity of my job is to attend court . . . I am scheduled for court on . . . Wednesday, February 22, 2006."

I am reluctant to grant this request. Ms. Servance did not indicate the nature of her job, or why it is impossible for her to attend the hearing. She also did not obtain the agreement of PGW before making her request.

On the other hand, in response to my inquiry, counsel for PGW indicated that he did not oppose the request. Therefore, I will grant her request for a continuance. Ms. Servance must understand, however, that no further continuances will be granted unless she establishes extremely good cause.

I strongly urge the parties to use this opportunity to attempt to resolve the matter themselves, so that a hearing will not be necessary.




