INTERIM ORDER

On January 1, 2006, the customers of Pike County Light & Power Company (Pike) experienced a significant increase in their generation rates. By Order dated February 14, 2006, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) initiated a 60-day investigation into the competitive market conditions in Pike's service territory at Docket Number P-00052168. The PUC directed parties to respond to a series of questions that addressed the lack of competitive options in Pike's service territory and the high cost of default generation service. The Order required the PUC's Law Bureau to file a report on the investigation after the conclusion of the investigation. On March 10, 2006, Direct Energy, LLC, a licensed electric generation supplier, filed a Petition with the PUC seeking to implement an auction for retail aggregation service in order to bring some rate relief to Pike's customers. The PUC approved Direct Energy's Petition, with modifications, on April 20, 2006. The above referenced Formal Complaints, investigation and Direct Energy's Petition are related. On March 22, 2006, a Prehearing Notice was issued indicating that an Initial Prehearing Conference would be held on May 24, 2006 in Scranton, Pennsylvania. The OCA filed a Notice of Intervention and Public Statement on April 5, 2006. The Office of Small Business Advocate filed a Notice of Intervention and Public Statement on April 24, 2006. On May 5, 2006, the Office of Consumer Advocate filed a Motion for an extension of time for the scheduled prehearing conference. Due to the ongoing nature of parallel proceedings, the scheduled prehearing conference cannot be effective at this time, and the Motion should be

granted. Therefore, in the ordering paragraph below the prehearing conference will be cancelled and continued for a period of sixty days.



PREHEARING MEMORANDUM OF

I. INTRODUCTION

These complaints were filed in response to a significant rate increase experienced by customers of Pike County Power & Light Company ("PCPL") on January 1, 2006. The Commission instituted an investigation at Dkt. No. P-00052168, which resulted in a report and a hearing that solicited bidding electric marketers to offer to provide service.

Subsequently, a number of complaints were filed by PCPL customers and consolidated for hearing. A prehearing conference is scheduled for August 3, 2006 before ALJ Ember S. Jandebour. The prehearing memorandum is being filed in compliance with the ALJ directive.

II. ISSUES

The issues identified by Complainants are as follows:

1. The continuing level of unreasonably high electric rates, even with Direct Energy as a supplier;
2. Exploration of integration of PCPL's energy procurement after 2007 with its New York or New Jersey operations;

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3. Conduct of an independent study regarding costs and benefits of an inter-connection with PJM;
4. Conduct of an independent study regarding the costs and benefits of a sale of PCPL to a Pennsylvania electric utility or a rural electric cooperative;
5. Transfer of borderline customers to Metropolitan Edison Company;
6. Filing of a default service plan by December 31, 2006, so there can be a full twelve (12) months of Commission consideration;
7. Waiver of EDI rules for EGS entry if PCPL remains in New York/New Jersey;
8. Commission audit of service and outage issues.

It should be noted that all of these recommendations were made in the Commission Staff's Report issued June 22, 2006 (Report pp. 16-20).

### **III. LIST OF WITNESSES**

Complainants will file the testimony of Richard L. Snyder.

### **IV. DISMISSAL OF CASE**

Complainants oppose dismissal of the matters as not moot. Unreasonably high electric rates exist even under service by Direct Energy.

### **V. DIRECT ENERGY AS A PARTY**

Complainants do not object to including Direct Energy as an indispensable party.


### **VI. DISCOVERY, HEARING SCHEDULE AND SETTLEMENT**
