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3 JUDGE KY VAN NGUYEN:

4 We open the record for a hearing on the  
5 complaint of Mohammad Hogue against Philadelphia Gas  
6 Works at docket number C-20067083. My name's Ky Van  
7 Nguyen. I am an Administrative Law Judge presiding at  
8 this hearing. I would ask the parties to identify  
9 themselves for the record. Mr. Hogue, can you  
10 identify yourself for the record, please?

11 MR. HOGUE:

12 This is Mohammad. Is there anything I  
13 need to do like ---?

14 JUDGE NGUYEN:

15 No.

16 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

17 Just your name.

18 JUDGE NGUYEN:

24 Thank you. Mr. Farinas?

25 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

1 Good morning, Your Honor. Laureto  
2 Farinas, Counsel for the Philadelphia Gas Works.

3 JUDGE NGUYEN:

4 Do you wish ---?

5 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

6 Mr. Hogue has graciously agreed to settle  
7 this matter with PGW. The terms of the settlement are  
8 as follows. The current balance owed to PGW for gas  
9 usage at 2949 North 22nd Street, Philadelphia,  
10 Pennsylvania is \$1,824.79. PGW will credit the  
11 account in the amount of \$913, leaving a remaining  
12 balance of \$911.79. Mr. Hogue has agreed to pay that  
13 amount and a deposit in the amount of \$300 and a  
14 service restoration fee in the amount of \$123.23 in  
15 one installment, for a total payment of \$1,335.02.  
16 You will make this payment within 30 days from today,  
17 and he will also, at the same time, visit PGW district  
18 office to schedule the restoration of service at 2949  
19 North 22nd Street.

20 JUDGE NGUYEN:

21 Okay. Thank you. Mr. Hogue?

22 MR. HOGUE:

23 Yes?

24 JUDGE NGUYEN:

25 Are those terms agreeable to you?

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MR. HOGUE:

Yes. I will do that.

JUDGE NGUYEN:

Okay. Thank you. Thank you very much.

We are adjourned. I expect a certificate.


