3 JUDGE CHARLES E. RAINEY JR.:

4 Good afternoon. My name is Charles
5 Rainey and I am the Administrative Law Judge who's
6 been assigned to this case. And this is the case of
7 Eddiesteen Burno versus Philadelphia Gas Works at
8 docket number C-20067113. I note the appearances by
9 telephone of Eddiesteen Burno, who is appearing Pro Se
10 or in her own behalf, and also the appearance of
11 Laureto Farinas, Esquire, who is appearing on behalf
12 of Philadelphia Gas Works.

13 It is my understanding the parties have
14 arrived at a settlement this afternoon, and I'm going
15 to ask Mr. Farinas at this time to state the terms of
16 the settlement for the record.

17 ATTORNEY FARINOS:

18 Thank you, Your Honor. Ms. Burno, as you
19 mentioned, graciously agreed to settle this matter
20 with PGW. The settlement terms are as follows. Ms.
21 Burno is currently enrolled in the customer of
22 responsibility program and her current payment --- her
23 current balance on her current account is \$96.08 and
24 is due on March 26th, 2007. PGW will put a credit on
25 her account in the amount of \$100.

1 JUDGE RAINEY:

2 Ms. Burno?

3 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

4 I'm sorry. Could you speak a little
5 louder?

6 MS. BURNO:

7 Yes.

8 JUDGE RAINEY:

9 Have you heard the terms of the
10 settlement stated by Mr. Farinas? Ms. Burno?

11 MS. BURNO:

12 You didn't hear me?

13 JUDGE RAINEY:

14 No, I didn't hear you.

15 MS. BURNO:

16 Yes, I did.

17 JUDGE RAINEY:

18 And are you in agreement with those
19 terms?

20 MS. BURNO:

21 I accept it.

22 JUDGE RAINEY:

23 Okay. Mr. Farinas, I'm going to ask you
24 to file a Certificate of Satisfaction within five days
25 from today. And, of course, provide copies of that to

1 Ms. Burno as well as to me.

2 Ms. Burno, when Mr. Farinas files that
3 certificate of satisfaction and provides you with a
4 copy, you'll have ten days in which to file any
5 written objections to the Certificate of Satisfaction.
6 If you do not, then the case will proceed to close.

7 Ms. Burno, do you have any questions?

8 MS. BURNO:

9 I think he's cleared up everything,
10 pretty much. But I didn't know about the law
11 beforehand, but I really hope that, for the record,
12 that everybody else like this, you know, gets a notice
13 before, you know, something that happened to me.

14 JUDGE RAINEY:

15 Okay.

16 MS. BURNO:

17 And I'm a little sad. I'm a little sad,
18 but I have to accept it because I have to get
19 something, better than get nothing.

20 JUDGE RAINEY:

21 So you are in agreement with this
22 settlement?

23 MS. BURNO:

24 I mean, I feel like from I can see is all
25 I can accept, because of the law that, you know, he

1 showed me already.

2 JUDGE RAINEY:

3 Mr. Farinas, then we will look forward to
4 your filing that Certificate of Satisfaction within
5 five days from today. I'm sorry, Mr. Farinas, I can't
6 hear you.

7 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

8 Then I will do so, Your Honor.

9 JUDGE RAINEY:

10 Okay. Very good. Okay. Is there
11 anything else that we need to take up here this
12 afternoon?

13 ATTORNEY FARINAS:

14 I have nothing further, Your Honor.

15 JUDGE RAINEY:

16 Ms. Burno, do you have anything further?

17 MS. BURNO:

18 No, I don't.

19 JUDGE RAINEY:

20 I'd like to thank the parties for
21 arriving at a settlement in regards to this case. And
22 hearing nothing further, then this hearing is
23 adjourned. Thank you all very much, and have a good
24 afternoon.


