Dear Mr. McNulty,

I received the INITIAL DECISION on this case on June 2, 2007. According to the law, I have twenty days from the date that I receive this decision with which to file an appeal. Therefore, the FINAL DECISION which I received in the mail today, and which you and not Judge Nene signed, and dated June 11, 2007, is moot.

The INITIAL DECISION was never sent to me by Mr. Fred A. Nene, Administrative Judge, and I really do not understand why. I do not understand why I did not receive a copy of his decision until June 2, 2007, which was a considerable amount of time from the signature date April 11, 2007 of the INITIAL DECISION. I can only suspect that you withheld the order so that I would be denied due process upon appeal, a right guaranteed by both the United States Government and the State of Pennsylvania. I believe that I should be allowed the same amount of time which you withheld that order from the time Honorable Nene penned this order to the day I received that order, to file my appeal. That was 7 and 1/2 weeks, or 52 days.

Therefore, if I do not hear from you in three days, I will assume that you assent to allowing me that time and accordingly, I will send the appeal for this case to the Commission on July 25, 2007, a rightful compensation for your withholding the INITIAL DECISION from me. After the appeal is received and considered and there is an order from that appeal, I shall be in the correct position to be handed a "FINAL DECISION".
