ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CYNTHIA W. FORDHAM: I am Administrative Law Judge Cynthia Williams Fordham and this is the time and place for a hearing in the matter of Aaris I. Churchill versus Philadelphia Gas Works at Docket Number F-02296743.

I note for the record the appearance of the complainant, Aaris I. Churchill prose' and Laureto Farinas, Esquire for the Philadelphia Gas Works.

Prior to going on the record the parties engaged in settlement negotiations, were you able to reach a settlement in this matter?

MR. FARINAS: Yes, Your Honor, we're happy to report that we were able reach a settlement and the terms of that settlement are as follows:

This matter concerns gas usage to 2432 North 54th Street in Philadelphia. The current balance to Ms. Churchill's account is \$4,391.02. Ms. Churchill has entered into a payment arrangement consisting of a payment of PGW's budget plan of \$444.00 a month plus \$73.00 for 60 months. Ms. Churchill is aware of the fact that the budget plan payment will flucuate according to usage and Ms. Cronley has discussed some conservation methods with Ms. Churchill.

Also this payment arrangement will begin with the payment of Ms. Churchill's PGW bill with the April 2008

1 due date. So, she would likely receive the payment
2 arrangement bill, the bill for March, but that payment
3 will not be due until April 2008.

4 JUDGE FORDHAM: Ms. Churchill are you in
5 agreement with the payment arrangements outlined by Mr.
6 Farinas?

7 MS. CHURCHILL: Reluctantly, yes, I am.

8 JUDGE FORDHAM: Based on that there will be no
9 need for a hearing in this matter. I thank the parties
10 for engaging in settlement negotiations. I know that
11 there were a lot of issues, so I do thank you for your
12 participation and the Commission thanks you.

13 At this time we will not have a hearing in this
14 matter. Mr. Farinas will file a Certificate of
15 Satisfaction and after a period of time the hearing will
16 be marked closed by the Commission. Thank you very
17 much.


