7 Mr. Farinas, do you have a motion you'd like to

13 because it was really hard to understand looking at his  
14 complaint --

15 MR. FARINAS: Sure.

16 JUDGE SCHNIERLE: Was his complaint that the bill  
17 was incorrect?

18 MR. FARINAS: Well, Your Honor, what I understand  
19 from his complaint is that he simply wanted a changed in  
20 his payment arrangement that was given by the Bureau of  
21 Consumer Services from \$100 per month plus a budget amount,  
22 to \$25 per month plus the budget amount.

23 JUDGE SCHNIERLE: Well, I guess what I'm getting at  
24 is, what precipitated that particular complaint? Was it a  
25 inability to pay, or --

1 MR. FARINAS: I would assume so, I mean, his  
2 inability or his unwillingness to pay.

3 JUDGE SCHNIERLE: All right. Your motion will be  
4 granted by a decision to be signed later today.

5 MR. FARINAS: Thank you

6 JUDGE SCHNIERLE: Is there anything further we need  
7 to discuss?

8 MR. FARINAS: Nothing further, Your Honor.

9 JUDGE SCHNIERLE: In that case, this hearing is  
10 adjourned.

13 JUDGE SCHNIERLE: Bye.


