**While you wait for us to reach a decision on your complaint, you must pay all undisputed bills (ones that are not a part of your complaint). As long as you pay all undisputed bills and return these formal complaint forms to us on time, the company is not permitted to terminate your service.**

**Commission Procedures for Formal Complaints**

- We send a copy of this letter to the company so they know you are appealing the Bureau of Consumer Services' decision;
- We also send the company a copy of your completed formal complaint forms. Once they receive it, they have 20 days to send us an answer to your complaint. The company will send you a copy of their answer.

- Once we receive all the paperwork, we usually will schedule your hearing before an Administrative Law Judge.
- We will notify both you and the company by mail when the hearing date is set.
- If you cannot travel to your hearing, you can request that the hearing be held by phone. This is called a telephonic hearing. If we can, we will schedule a telephonic hearing for you.
- We will most likely schedule your hearing sometime within three months after you file your complaint forms. If you know of certain dates when you will not be available for a hearing, let us know when you file your forms. We will try to work around your schedule.
- **If you cannot attend the hearing on the scheduled date, you must request a different time or date. You should request the change at least 5 days before your hearing by writing to:**

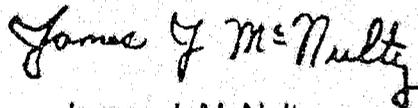

You contacted the Public Utility Commission asking for help in preventing the termination of your utility service. We looked into your records with the company and decided that:

- Your total account balance is \$951.28. This balance does not include any payments or bills sent out on or after 9/22/2006.
- Beginning WITH THE NOVEMBER, 2006 DUE DATE, you must pay the company a special budget amount of \$247.00 per month. This amount may change depending on any change in the amount of service you use.
- This special budget amount includes a regular budget amount of \$231.00 per month, which is based on your monthly usage, plus \$16.00 that will be paid toward the account balance.
- You must make all payments by the due date of each month's bill and continue making the payments until you pay the account in full.
- The company will not charge late payment fees to your account as long as you pay according to this decision. However, the company may apply late payment fees if you do not pay on time or if you do not keep this agreement.
- Based on the information you gave us, you appear to be eligible for ONTRACK. ONTRACK is a program that may reduce your budget and forgive your outstanding balance. Our review finds this may be the best rate for you. To receive this rate, you must contact the company to apply. They will tell you how to apply for ONTRACK. If the company enrolls you in ONTRACK, they will tell you the new amount you need to pay each month.
- If you break this payment agreement, the company may shut off your service. If the company shuts off your service, they may make you pay your full bill plus a reconnect fee and a deposit to restore service.

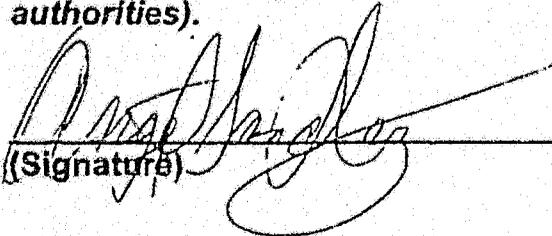

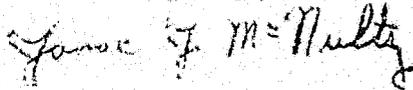

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TO: PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

TAKE NOTICE:

That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,

1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the **Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265**, an answer (original and three copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated by the date at the top of this Notice. Section 1.56(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 1.56(a).

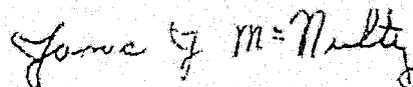
2. If you fail to either satisfy this complaint or to file answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, you will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this complaint in accordance with Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61. In that event, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if

you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

3. If you elect to satisfy this complaint you must file, within twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served, affidavits executed by each complainant that this complaint has been satisfied. Such affidavits must describe the basis on which this complaint was satisfied; any settlement agreement between the parties must be reduced to writing and attached to the affidavit. Such affidavits are to be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the address set forth in paragraph 1. Upon receipt of affidavits of satisfaction from all complainants, this complaint may be dismissed by the Commission in accordance with Section 703(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 703(a), unless the Commission determines that such dismissal would be contrary to the public interest, in which event the Commission may direct that hearings be held upon the complaint.

4. If you file an answer which admits the allegations in this complaint, or which fails to specifically deny the allegations in this complaint, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

5. If you file a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this complaint, or which raises material questions of law or fact, this matter shall be referred to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, you are found to have committed any of the violations alleged in the complaint, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. In the imposition of a penalty after a hearing the Administrative Law Judge is not bound by the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

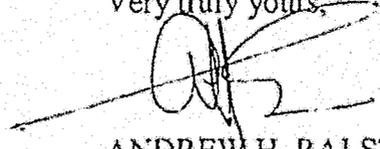

ANSWER OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (hereafter "PPL"), by its attorney, hereby answers the Complaint in the above-captioned proceeding as follows:

1. Admitted.
2. Admitted. By way of further response, the Respondent Utility is PPL, not PPL Electric Service.
3. PPL admits that it is an electric utility company.
4. Denied. PPL denies that Complainant Angel Sanchez (hereafter "Complainant")

is unable to pay the regular budget bill of \$231 in addition to \$16 a month towards the overdue balance, as indicated in the most recent BCS Decision, or that PPL has been unreasonable in billing Complainant or in any other way in this matter. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a copy of the Bureau of Consumer Services Decision dated September 22, 2006 at Docket Number 2146079.

By way of further response, Complainant's total account balance as of November 27, 2006 is \$1,387.99. Complainant's payments on this account have been sporadic, making only three (3) payments since the account was opened on March 31, 2006. PPL has made reasonable payment arrangements on this account, and Complainant has defaulted

PPL does not have sufficient information to either admit or deny Complainant's allegations regarding Complainant's ability to pay, and strict proof regarding the same is hereby demanded by trial.

PPL does not have sufficient information to either admit or deny all other allegations in Complainant's Complaint. Therefore, all such allegations are denied, and strict proof regarding the same is hereby demanded by trial.

5. Denied. Paragraph 5 of the Complaint concerns a request for relief to which no answer is required. To the extent a further response is required, PPL incorporates by reference herein its aforementioned response to Paragraph 4 of the Complaint.

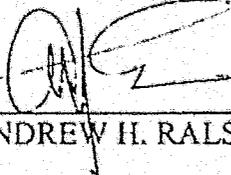
6. Denied. After reasonable investigation, PPL is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of this allegation and, therefore, the same is denied.

7. Admitted.

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, PPL respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission deny the above-captioned Complaint, and dismiss the Complaint based on the provision of Act 201, Chapter 1405(D), 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 1405(d), which states that "absent a change" in income, the Commission shall not establish a second or subsequent payment agreement if a customer has defaulted on a previous payment agreement.

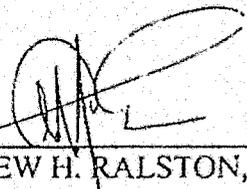
