3 hearing scheduled at Docket F-02261201, Frank Bowie versus PECO Energy
4 Company. For the record, let me state that I am Administrative Law
5 Judge, Marlane R. Chestnut and I will note the following appearance for the
6 record. Michael Swerling representing PECO Energy Company.

7 I note that the Complainant is not present and did not contact this
8 office to indicate that he would or would not appear. Mr. Swerling.

9 MR. SWERLING: Yes, Your Honor. At this time, PECO Energy
10 would request that this case be dismissed with prejudice for failure to
11 prosecute. I will note that Mr. Bowie had a formal complaint in 2004 where
12 he also failed to show up and it seems like he has again failed to show up.
13 If it was a Civil Court, I would probably ask for sanctions but I am not
14 going to do anything here.

15 JUDGE CHESTNUT: I will note that on the record that it is a pattern
16 and your motion is granted. Anything further?

17 MR. SWERLING: I have nothing further, Your Honor.

18 JUDGE CHESTNUT: Thank you very much and this hearing is
19 adjourned.
