1 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CYNTHIA W. FORDHAM: I am
2 Administrative Law Judge Cynthia Williams Fordham and
3 this is the time and place for a hearing in the matter
4 of Primus Muganyizi versus Philadelphia Gas Works at
5 Docket Number F-02294765.

6 I note for the record the appearance of the
7 complainant, Primus Muganyizi prose and Laureto Farinas,
8 Esquire for the Philadelphia Gas Works.

9 Prior to going on the record the parties engaged
10 in settlement negotiations were the parties successful?

11 MR. FARINAS: Yes, Your Honor, we are happy to
12 say that we were able to reach a settlement.

13 JUDGE FORDHAM: Okay. Would you like to put the
14 terms on on the record,

15 MR. FARINAS: Your Honor, this matter has to do
16 with calcuation of alleged unauthorized usage of gas
17 2548 South Millet Street in Philadelphia. The terms of
18 the settlement are as follows:

19 PGW will enter two credits onto Mr. Muganyizi's
20 account for gas service at that address and the first
21 credit is in the amount of \$1,783.62. and another credit
22 which was a turn-on charge a separate amount of \$123.23.

23 By virtue of the settlement, Mr. Muganyizi has
24 requested that the refund of the amount of \$1,783.62
25 sent to him, and PGW will refund this money to him in

1 due course.

2 JUDGE FORDHAM: And the \$123.23.

3 MR. FARINAS: Remains for the turn-on fee, but
4 credited to his account.

5 JUDGE FORDHAM: Okay. Mr. Muganyizi, are you in
6 agreement with the terms that have been outlined by Mr.
7 Farinas?

8 MR. MUGANYIZI: Yes.

9 JUDGE FORDHAM: Based on that there is no need to
10 have a hearing in this matter and Mr. Farinas will file
11 a Certificate of Satisfaction and the Commission will
12 mark this matter closed.

13 I thank the parties for engaging in settlement
14 negotiations, so that we would not have to have a hearing
15 and a decision. Thank you very much. Have a good day.

16 (Whereupon, at 9:53 a.m. the hearing was
17 adjourned.)


