
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:


O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED:


1. That William J. McAndrew pay current electric bills as they become due plus the sum of \$50.00 every two weeks toward arrearages.







MOTION TO DISMISS

---

Pennsylvania Power & Light Company, (hereafter "PP&L"), by its attorney, hereby moves to dismiss complainant's request to reopen this matter and states as follows:

1. A telephonic hearing was held in this matter on March 9, 1982. The complainant requested that the Commission find out why his electric bill was so high, although complainant did not dispute the accuracy of his bills or the amount of his arrearage (Tr. 25). At the hearing, complainant and PP&L reached a settlement under which complainant agreed to pay current bills plus \$50.00 every two weeks. Complainant's arrearage at that time was \$439.03. This settlement was embodied in Administrative Law Judge Banzhoff's Initial Decision dated May 27, 1982, which became final pursuant to a Commission Order entered June 29, 1982.

2. Complainant has not adhered to this payment schedule, and as of September 22, 1982, complainant's balance was \$1,390.76. PP&L began termination procedures pursuant to Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code Chapter 56. Termination procedures have been suspended pending decision on complainant's request.

3. By letter dated September 16, 1982, complainant asked the Commission to reopen the original complaint and to stay his scheduled termination because he was "dissatisfied" with the hearing and judgment. Complainant also requested another hearing. PP&L received a copy of this letter on September 28, 1982.

4. The Commission should deny complainant's request for the following reasons:

a. The Public Utility Code provides that requests for rehearing must be made within fifteen (15) days of a final order. 66 Pa.C.S. §703(f). The instant request was made three months after the final order, four months after the Initial Decision, and six months after the settlement and hearing date.

b. Complainant has not alleged or presented any legitimate reasons or new evidence for reopening this matter. Overly tardy dissatisfaction with a settlement agreed to by complainant is an inadequate basis for reopening this docket.


c. Complainant has already been afforded the full benefit of the Commission's procedures at 52 Pa. Code Chapter 56.

d. In view of the foregoing, complainant should not be heard to request at this late date the reopening of the record in a matter that has been properly closed and final for three months.

WHEREFORE, in view of the above, PP&L respectfully requests that complainant's motion to reopen this proceeding be dismissed or denied.


