My wife has come down with a disease a few years ago that has caused parts of her joints to become deteriorated and inflamed. As of this writing, we are trying to determine which part of her body to have repaired first. This is consuming me and my time. I have been full time employed as a delivery driver for Martindale Propane as of the beginning of November 2016. On top of all of my wife's problems, I have a serious back condition as well. I was actually on Social Security disability for eight years before I started the trucking business. I too am fighting to keep working. I chose to become an employee to generate a secure major medical package.

I know the law is the law. I did not know I was going to be prosecuted for shutting down my company. I am overwhelmed with all of our personal health conditions. I know I should have been more attentive as to protocol with the PUC and the Federal Motor Carrier legalities.
