I represent Respondent, Airport Orbit, Inc., in connection with the above captioned Complaint proceeding. By letter dated December 13, 2016, I electronically filed with the Commission a letter from Respondent, dated December 8, 2016, advising the Commission that Respondent intended to terminate its certificated operations as of December 31, 2016 and requesting a one year voluntary suspension of its operating authority. A copy of my correspondence, dated December 13, 2016, and a copy of Respondent's letter, dated December 8, 2016, are attached. By Secretarial Letter dated February 8, 2017, Respondent was notified that its request for a voluntary suspension of its operating authority was denied.

I have been authorized to advise the Commission that, as planned, effective January 1, 2017, Respondent ceased to conduct any operations pursuant to its Certificate of Public Convenience and that Respondent has no intention of conducting any certificated operations in the future. Therefore, please be advised that Respondent has abandoned its PUC Certificate, and Respondent hereby requests that the Commission cancel all of its operating rights, including its airport transfer authority at Docket No. A-00120712 and its limousine operating rights at Docket No. A-00120712, Folder 2.

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am the sole founder, sole stockholder and President of Airport Orbit, Inc., which holds a Certificate of Public Convenience from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at lead Docket No. A-00120712. Airport Orbit purchased airport transfer service operating rights from Cultural Studies Academy, Inc., t/d/b/a Lenz Travel Airport Shuttle Service, in 2004 and acquired additional operating authority at Docket No. A-00120712, F.2 in 2016 to provide limousine service. (The airport transfer service operating rights and limousine operating rights are referred to as "Operating Rights.") After managing the business of Airport Orbit as a certificated carrier on a 24 hour a day, 7 day a week basis for the past 12 years, I have decided for a number of reasons to retire from the passenger transportation business, effective January 1, 2017. I intend to seek a buyer for Airport Orbit's business assets and its operating authority. I am notifying the Commission of my plan to cease providing certificated service after December 31, 2016 in order to comply with the Commission's interruption of service regulations at 52 Pa. Code §29.62.

I am hereby requesting that the Commission grant Airport Orbit a voluntary suspension of its Operating Rights for a period of one year, from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, in order to allow time to locate a buyer of Airport Orbit's business and/or Operating Rights. During the suspension period, I intend to cancel Airport Orbit's insurance and arrange for notice of cancellation of insurance to be filed with the Commission. This will allow Airport Orbit to avoid incurring the expense of paying insurance premiums when it is not conducting any certificated motor carrier operations.


