Dear Judge Long and Judge Watson:

Consistent with Your Honors' Interim Order dated December 16, 2016, this is to confirm to you that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") by Order Adopted and Entered on January 26, 2017 granted Rasier-PA LLC ("Rasier"), the Applicant in the above-captioned proceeding, a license to operate as a Transportation Network Company throughout Pennsylvania pursuant to Act 164. The granting of this license effectively makes unnecessary continued prosecution of Rasier's Application proceeding at Docket No. A-2015-2469287.

Counsel for Billtown Cab Co., Inc. and MTR Transportation Inc., t/d/b/a K-Cab Co., the only other parties to this proceeding, concurs with Rasier that this matter before the Commission may be withdrawn and the docket considered closed without further proceedings.
