**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

Code § 1.15(b), Philadelphia Gas Works, the Respondent (PGW or the “Company”) hereby requests a continuance of the Initial Telephonic Hearing in this matter scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Friday, April 14, 2017, as there has been a change in counsel, who will be unavailable at the scheduled hearing time. In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:

1. On or about January 5, 2017, the Commission served the Respondent, PGW with the Complaint filed in the above captioned matter, to which PGW filed an Answer on January 25, 2017.
2. By Notice dated March 9, 2017, the Commission scheduled an Initial Telephonic Hearing in this matter for Friday, April 14, 2017 at 10:00 a.m., before Special Agent Rebecca Waldemar. Special Agent Waldemar will preside over the telephonic hearing from the Commission’s Harrisburg office.
3. The hearing date, April 14, 2017 is a day that PGW offices are closed. It is Good Friday, a religious holiday. The PGW witness for that matter will not be available to give testimony.
4. On March 13, 2017, counsel for PGW contacted the Complainant, Mr. Hodges EI concerning PGW’s request for a continuance. Mr. Hodges EI, has indicated that he does not object to this request for a continuance of the hearing of this matter.
5. PGW has not previously requested a continuance in this matter.

6. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), PGW has shown good cause for the grant of a continuance in this matter.


