**SECOND ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The current procedural schedule in the above-captioned matter is as follows.

Evidentiary Hearings	March 21-22, 2017

On March 15, 2017, I received an e-mail informing me that the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) and Clearview Electric, Inc. (“Clearview”) reached a settlement-in-principle in the above-captioned matter. The parties requested the cancellation of the evidentiary hearing and sought permission to submit a Joint Settlement Petition by April 21, 2017.

Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa.Code § 5.223, the request shall be granted and the evidentiary hearing scheduled for March 21-22, 2017 shall be cancelled. The parties have leave until April 21, 2017, within which time to file a joint petition for settlement with statements in support, stipulations as to findings of fact, and stipulations with regard to the submission of any evidence into the record. In the event that the parties fail to reduce their verbal agreement into a written joint petition for settlement filed on or before April 21, 2017, a hearing will be rescheduled.

THEREFORE,  
IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule at Docket No. C-2016-254392 is hereby suspended.
2. That the evidentiary hearing scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on March 21-22, 2017, is cancelled.
3. That the parties have leave until April 21, 2017, within which time to file a joint petition for settlement with statements in support, stipulations as to findings of fact, and stipulations with regard to the submission of any evidence into the record.
4. That in the event no joint petition for settlement is filed on or before April 21, 2017, the hearing will be rescheduled.
