Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

By Certificate of Satisfaction filed on June 30, 2016 at Docket No. C-2015-2498921 by directive of presiding Administrative Law Judge Angela T. Jones, as set forth during the on-the-record discussion that took place on June 16, 2016, Respondent agreed to pay all assessment amounts then due. In addition, Respondent agreed to submit to the Commission \$27,803 on or before December 31, 2016 to satisfy Respondent's outstanding amount for the July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 Fiscal Year (2015-2016 Fiscal Year). Respondent failed to pay its 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Assessment by December 30, 2016. As such, I&E instituted the above-docketed formal complaint and sought a further civil penalty.

Respondent, Celebrity Limousine, has now paid the amounts sought by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") in order to amicably resolve the above-docketed complaint as well as satisfy the terms of the Certificate of Satisfaction filed at C-2015-2498921. On February 15, 2017, the Commission received payment in the amount of \$27,803 which was Respondent's outstanding assessment due for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year. On March 8, 2017, the Commission received an additional payment of \$4,170 which was the negotiated civil penalty agreed to by the parties to resolve the above-referenced complaint.

The assessment amount and civil penalty having been paid, I&E files this letter pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Section 5.24(a), to certify that the above-docketed matter has been satisfied and should be marked closed.
