Dear Ms. Chiavetta:

On February 27, 2017, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) issued a Secretarial Letter stating that the Commission disapproved the proposed Interconnection Agreement between PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's (PPL Electric) and Clinton County Solid Waste Authority (CCSWA). The Secretarial Letter stated that the application filed by PPL Electric did not provide sufficient documentation supporting CCSWA declaration that it will own the engines used to generate renewable energy. The Secretarial Letter provided PPL Electric and CCSWA with the option of resubmitting the application with the requested information. Pursuant to the Secretarial Letter, enclosed for filing is *PPL Electric's Review and Recommendation of Eligibility for the Net Metering Application of CCSWA*, updated to include additional information provided by CCSWA.

The Company requests that the enclosed information be treated by the Commission as **privileged and confidential**.

The *PPL Electric's Review and Recommendation of Eligibility for the Net Metering Application of CCSWA* contains the following:

- PPL Electric's Review and Recommendation, revised March 27, 2017;
- CCSWA's Interconnection Application¹;
- Appendix A - Documentation to support CCSWA's declaration that it will own or operate the three engines that will generate renewable energy from the landfill gas;

¹ PPL Electric notes that a previous Secretarial Letter issued in this matter on December 28, 2016, stated that CCSWA's application did not include a Net Metering Application as required by the Net Metering Rider in PPL Electric's tariff. PPL Electric does not have a Net Metering Application available for CCSWA to complete and include in this filing.



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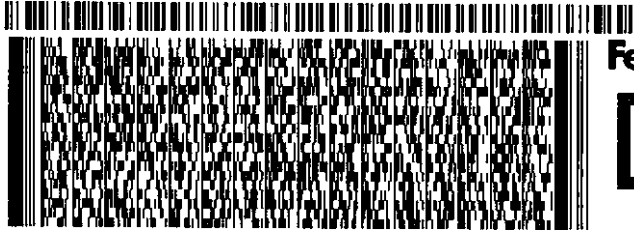

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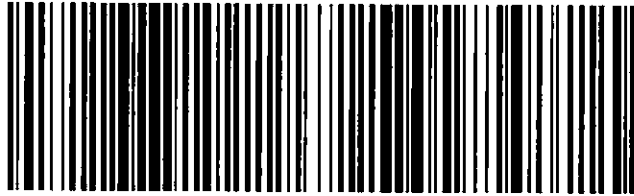
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
