<u>Item 3.a</u>: AFFILIATES: Yardi has five domestic wholly-owned subsidiaries and eleven international wholly-owned subsidiaries. Yardi and its subsidiaries are engaged in the provision of software services to the real estate industry, and none of the subsidiaries are jurisdictional public utilities. The Electricity Broker Services will be conducted by the company's Energy Division, located in Valhalla, NY. Item 4.c: PROPOSED SERVICES: Yardi proposes to offer the following electric services in Pennsylvania:

- Competitive energy procurement for electricity supply, including green energy sources (Electric Broker):
 The process includes conducting market research, energy profiling, legal review of contracts, running the RFP process, bid analysis and presentation of financial implications of various pricing options to the client.
- Tracking, budgeting and reporting energy and emissions, including calculating and forecasting carbon footprints: The company's patented E2TrackSM web-based software centrally collects and monitors usage, costs, supply-contract performances and budget variances for electricity, steam, water, natural gas and fuel oil. These analytical tools help clients understand how a building uses energy and how that usage can be cost-effectively controlled. The budget module allows clients to create and modify energy/utility budgets as necessary. E2TrackSM also allows clients to track all components of their carbon footprint. As part of the "Green Initiatives" program, E2TrackSM calculates and displays direct and indirect emissions associated with the operations of an individual property, portfolio or company. It also reports all emission sources contributing to the total carbon footprint, including energy, travel, waste, paper, HCFCs, and others. E2TrackSM also provides an audit trail for compliance and helps clients satisfy environmental reporting as required by their own criteria and/or by the International Standards Organization, GHG Protocol and EPA Climate Leaders.
- <u>Developing and implementing green initiatives</u>: The Energy Division develops requests for pricing
 (RFPs) from green energy suppliers, negotiates contract terms and conditions, solicits prices from
 suppliers and secures final contracts for execution. The company also develops and presents a matrix



The fee payment methods are: (1) Periodic or lump-sum payment of fees directly by the client to Yardi, or (2) the addition of the fee to the Contract Price offered by the electricity supplier. If the fee is payable by the electricity supplier, payment is typically made on a monthly or quarterly basis, and is typically only payable if the supplier receives payment for the corresponding monthly electricity invoice from the customer. The electricity supplier payment obligation is reflected in a written agreement between the supplier and Yardi.

Yardi is a California corporation and is privately owned. Yardi was founded in 1984 by Anant Yardi, who continues to serve as President. The corporate headquarters is located at 430 S. Fairview Avenue, Goleta, CA 93117. Yardi and its domestic and international subsidiaries are engaged in the provision of software services to the real estate industry, and none of the subsidiaries have previous experience in the electricity industry.

In addition to its primary software applications providing operations, accounting and ancillary processes and services, Yardi has developed energy-related software options to actively manage consumption, cut costs and support environmental initiatives. Yardi offers a LOBOS software system to its clients, which is an HVAC optimization system that offers improved comfort, energy efficiency and fully automated demand response capability. The sales and management of the LOBOS software systems is based in

Yardi's Irvine, CA location. In addition, two of Yardi's domestic subsidiaries, YES Energy Management, Inc. and YES Multifamily, Inc., provide utility billing software and meter installation services to commercial real estate owners and managers. These entities are located in Colorado Springs, CO and Alpharetta, GA.

The Electricity Broker Services which are the subject of this Application will be conducted by the company's Energy Division, located in the metropolitan New York City region, in Valhalla, NY. The Energy Division is under the direction of the company's Regional Director, Northeast Region, Margaret (Meg) Carey, who is responsible for the day-to-day operations. Ms. Carey previously founded MCENERGY, INC. (MCE), a New York corporation, in 1996. MCE started to provide energy consulting services, including Electricity Broker Services, to the commercial real estate community in New York City in 1999. Since then, MCE expanded its operations to include the northeastern U.S., including the Chicago metropolitan region.

In August 2015, Ms. Carey signed an agreement with Yardi for the sale of substantially all the assets of MCE to Yardi. MCE currently holds an Electric Generation Supplier License, Number A-2012-2291186, issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission on 04/26/12. The transfer of MCE's operations in Pennsylvania will be completed following the issuance of an Electric Generation Supplier License to Yardi, as contemplated by this Application. Upon issuance of the License to Yardi, MCE will be giving notice of cancellation to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission with respect to MCE's License in Pennsylvania.

 - Maryland: Applicant was issued a "License to Supply Electric Generation Services" on 08/31/16 by the Maryland Public Service Commission (License No. IR-3733). A copy of the letter evidencing the issuance of the License is attached to the Application.
 - New York: No license is required for the Applicant to provide Electric Broker Services in this
 jurisdiction.
 - Ohio: Applicant was issued a "Certificate as a Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider" on 05/05/16 by the Ohio Public Utility Commission (Certificate No. 16-1072E(1)). A copy of the Certificate evidencing issuance of the certification is attached to the Application.
 - <u>Texas</u>: No license is required for the Applicant to provide Electric Broker Services in this jurisdiction.

In addition to the states listed above, Yardi's Energy Division initially plans to provide Electric Broker Services in New Jersey and the District of Columbia. Applicant currently has an "Energy Agent Initial Registration" application submitted to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities, which is under review.

Applicant also currently has an "Electric Generation Services Supplier License" application submitted to the District of Columbia Public Service Commission, which is currently under review. The Applicant's predecessor, MCE, provided electricity broker services in the states listed above, and held applicable licenses. As stated above, MCE currently holds a License in Pennsylvania, and will be requesting cancellation following the issuance of a License to Yardi.

• Type and Number of Customers Applicant Currently Serves in Other Jurisdictions:

Yardi currently provides Electric Broker Services to Large Commercial (over 25 kW), Industrial and Governmental Customers. Yardi will not be providing Electric Broker Services to Residential or Small Commercial Customers. Yardi currently represents over 60 clients in other jurisdictions, including Fortune 500 companies, nationally recognized commercial real estate managers and public and private commercial real estate trusts.

• Staffing Structure and Numbers and Employee Training Commitments:

Yardi has over 5,000 employees world-wide, with approximately 24 offices located in North America and 10 offices located in Europe, the Middle East and Australia.

Approximately 15 people are located at the Valhalla office. The Electric Broker Services will be carried out by a staff of approximately 10 people, each with experience and expertise in the company's service offerings.

The client services for the Electric Broker activities are conducted by the company's Energy Analyst Group, which reports to Meg Carey, Regional Director, Northeast Region. The Energy Analyst personnel each have experience and expertise in the company's service offerings. The company's training commitments for new and existing employees is as follows:

- New employees are trained by senior staff on process and procedures as documented in the company's business manual;
- Weekly staff meetings are conducted to manage the client process, address client concerns and share information and resolution techniques among staff;
- Monthly seminars are held on different topics on energy market trends and regulatory changes;
- The company maintains subscriptions to trade journals and on-line energy reports to keep abreast of current market developments; and
- The company pays for employees to attend industry-sponsored energy forums and seminars.
- Business Plan for Operations in Pennsylvania: (Please refer to Item 4.c above for a more detailed description of each service offering):
 - Competitive energy procurement for electricity supply, including green energy sources;
 - Tracking, budgeting and reporting energy and emissions, including calculating and forecasting carbon footprints:
 - Developing and implementing green initiatives; and
 - Sub-metering services including sub-meter reading, tenant billing and sub-meter installation.

<u>Item 8.d</u>: **OVERSIGHT OF MARKETING**: Marketing activities for the Electric Broker Services are the responsibility of Meg Carey, Regional Director, Northeast Region. Marketing efforts are based on development of existing client relationships, referrals, responses to client RFPs, and maintenance of the company website. Yardi will use its own internal resources and employees for marketing, and Yardi will not use subcontractors for its marketing activities. Yardi will not be engaging in any telemarketing or door-to-door sales solicitation activities.

Item 8.e: OFFICERS: Meg Carey, Regional Director, Northeast Region, who is based in Valhalla, NY, is directly responsible for the operations of the Energy Broker Services. She reports to the Director of Energy Management, Matt Eggers, who is based in Yardi's office in San Francisco, CA. Mr. Eggers is responsible for the financial and corporate integration of the Energy Division with Yardi's upper management. Mr. Eggers reports to Anant Yardi, President and founder of Yardi Systems, Inc. The professional resumes for management personnel directly responsible for the operations of the Energy Broker Services are as follows:

• Anant Yardi, President

In 1982, Anant Yardi recognized the need for an integrated accounting and property management software for the residential marketplace. As the director of systems development for Burroughs Corporation (now Unisys) and with 14 years of programming experience, he knew he had the background to design such a product. In 1984, Anant founded Yardi Systems, Inc. (Yardi), and "Basic Property Management" was created for the Apple II computer and was sold to the company's first customer, Sabaco Realtors. Since that time, Anant has directed the company through over 30 years of steady growth as Yardi became a leader in real estate asset and property management solutions.

Today, Anant continues to serve as President of Yardi, and his vision is the driving force behind the development of effective and innovative software solutions for global real estate portfolio management. He has been recognized as one of the early pioneers in the commercial real estate automation industry, a "visionary in respect to automation systems and the resultant benefits in property operations," according to Realcomm, when they honored him with the 2004 "Digie" award. He was inducted into the Multi-Housing News "Hall of Fame" that same year, and his company continues to receive industry accolades.

Anant has an M.A. in Engineering from the University of California at Berkeley, and worked for 14 years developing programming methodologies and directing systems development at Burroughs Corporation prior to establishing Yardi Systems, Inc.

Matt Eggers, Director Energy Management

Currently Matt is leading the charge in energy management and high performing buildings software for Yardi as the property management software company builds the most integrated solution in the market. He was previously Vice President of North American Sales at Tesla Motors. In this role he managed the retail and sales strategy, and led the 450-member sales team to record sales, and large gains in market share. Before Tesla he was VP of Operations and Software Product Management at Sunrun Inc. (NASDAQ: SUN) where he led the creation of Customer Care, Field Service, Project Operations and Order Management as Sunrun grew from 30 employees and 2,000 residential solar customers to 1,200 employees and more than 55,000 customers. Matt also led the software team that created and designed the industry's leading solar sales toolkit ("BrightPath"), customer website, and solar fleet management tools. Prior to Sunrun, Matt was Director of Product Management at the fuel cell company

Bloom Energy where he created the product requirements for the second gen "Bloom Box", led PR for a "60 Minutes" piece on Bloom, and worked in a sales team that closed \$20M in orders from customers including FedEx, Staples, eBay, Wal-Mart, and Google. Before Bloom, Matt was at Genentech where he led the commercial launch of Herceptin Adjuvant, a cancer drug with over \$1 billion in sales. Matt graduated magna cum laude with a B.S. in molecular biology from Duke University, and has an MBA from Stanford. Because of Meg's varied experience working with real estate owners, developers, managing agents and large commercial and industrial tenants, she knows firsthand the parameters by which investment decisions regarding energy efficiency are made. 

The undersigned certify that they are the President and Secretary, respectively, of Yardi Systems, a corporation organized and existing under the General Corporation Law of the State of California (the "Corporation"), and do hereby further certify that:

<u>FIRST</u>: The original Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation were filed with the Secretary of State of California on August 16, 1984.

<u>SECOND</u>: The Board of Directors and the Shareholders of the Corporation have determined that it is in the best interests of the Corporation to effect a stock split of its outstanding shares of capital stock (the "Stock Split").

<u>THIRD</u>: The Board of Directors and the Shareholders of the Corporation have determined that is in the best interest of the Corporation to increase the authorized numbers of shares of the Corporation's Common Stock from 1,000,000 to 22,000,000 (the "Increase in Authorized Shares").

<u>FOURTH</u>: The Board of Directors and the Shareholders of the Corporation have determined that is in the best interest of the Corporation to designate two (2) classes of Common Stock of the Corporation, namely the Class A Common Shares and the Class B Common Shares (the "Common Stock Designation"), and to convert each of the shares of Common Stock outstanding as of the date of these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation to Class A Common Stock and Class B Common Stock (the "Conversion").

FOURTH: In order to effect the Stock Split and the Increase in Authorized Shares, and the Common Stock Designation, the Shareholders, representing the required majority of the total number of 100,000 outstanding shares of Common Stock of the Corporation (there being no outstanding shares of Preferred Stock of the Corporation), and all members of the Board of Directors, have consented to, voted for and duly approved the Stock Split, the Increase in Authorized Shares, the Common Stock Designation and the Conversion as set forth in these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, pursuant to Section 902, 905 and other appropriate sections of the General Corporation Law of the State of California. The number of shares voting in favor of the amendment equaled or exceeded the vote required. The percentage vote required was more than 50%.

<u>FIFTH</u>: These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly approved and adopted by the Board of Directors and Shareholder, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 900, 902, 905, 907 and 910 and all other applicable provisions of the General Corporation Law of the State of California.

<u>SIXTH</u>: The Articles of Incorporation of this Corporation are hereby amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Yardi Systems.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the General Corporation Law of California other than the banking business, the trust company business or the practice of a profession permitted to be incorporated by the California Corporation Code.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is authorized to issue only two classes of shares of stock, designated as "Class A Common Shares" and "Class B Common Shares." The total authorized number of Class A Common Shares is 2,000,000, and the total authorized number of Class B Common Shares is 20,000,000. Each holder of Class A Common Shares shall be entitled to ten (10) votes per Class A Common Share, and each holder of Class B Common Shares shall be entitled to one (1) vote per Class B Common Share. Except as to voting rights, all shares of Class A Common Stock and Class B Common Stock shall be identical and shall entitle the holders thereof to the same rights and privileges.

ARTICLE IV

Each outstanding share of Common Stock of the Corporation, as of the date of these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, shall be converted into twenty (20) Class A Common Shares and one hundred (100) Class B Common Shares.

ARTICLE V

Before there can be a valid sale or transfer of any of the shares of this Corporation by any holder thereof, the holder of the shares to be sold or transferred shall first give notice in writing to the secretary of this Corporation of his intention to sell or transfer such shares. Said notice shall specify the number of shares to be sold or transferred, the price per share, and the terms upon which such holder intends to make such sale or transfer. The secretary shall, within five (5) days thereafter, mail or deliver a copy of said notice to each of the other shareholders of record of this Corporation. Such notice may be delivered to such shareholders personally or may be mailed to the last known addresses of such shareholders, as the same may appear on the books of this Corporation. Within twenty-one (21) days after the mailing or delivery of said notices to such shareholders, any such shareholder or shareholders desiring to acquire any part or all of the shares referred to in said notice shall deliver by mail or otherwise to the secretary of this Corporation a written offer or offers expressed to be acceptable immediately, to purchase a specified number or numbers of such shares at the price and upon the terms stated in

said notice, accompanied by the purchase price therefore with authorization to pay such purchase price against delivery of such shares.

If the total number of shares specified in such offers exceeds the number of shares referred to in said notice, each offering shareholder shall be entitled to purchase such proportion of the shares referred to in said notice to the secretary, as the number of shares of this Corporation, which he holds, bears to the total number of shares held by all such shareholders desiring to purchase the shares referred to in said notice to the secretary.

If all of the shares referred to in said notice to the secretary are not disposed of under such apportionment, each shareholder desiring to purchase shares in a number in excess of his proportionate share, as provided above, shall be entitled to purchase such proportion of those shares which remain undisposed above, as the total number of shares which he holds bears to the total number of shares held by all of the shareholders desiring to purchase shares in excess of those to which they are entitled under such apportionment.

If one or more of the other shareholders offers to purchase, in the aggregate, within said twenty-one (21) day period, less than all of the shares referred to in said notice to the secretary, the shareholder desiring to sell or transfer shall not be obligated to accept any such offer or offers from one or more of the other shareholders and may dispose of all of the shares of stock referred to in said notice, to any third party; provided, however, that he shall not sell or transfer such shares at a lower price or on terms more favorable to the purchaser or transferee than those specified in said notice to the secretary.

By the Commission:

I. INTRODUCTION

On December 24, 2015, Yardi Systems, Inc. ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454, "Licensure of Retail Electric Agents, Brokers and Consultants" ("Part 454"). Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois. Since all of the information to grant the requested relief was contained in the Application, the Hearing was waived.

II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of California and authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data. The Applicant has also attested that no complaints have been filed against it for its provision of services in the electric or gas industry in the jurisdictions where it provides or is seeking to provide services.

III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C

Applicant is required by Section 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Section 454.60 through Attachment 1 to the Application. Attachment 1 to the Application contains a corporate organizational chart and identifies the occupational background information of the persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a). Attachment 1 contains occupational background information on the person or persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Section 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Section 454.70 with the information provided in Attachment 1. Attachment 1 contains occupational background information on the person or persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.70(a).

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical, managerial, and financial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements. The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Yardi Systems, Inc. is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Yardi Systems, Inc., a business organized under the laws of California and authorized to transact business in Illinois, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof:
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) Yardi Systems, Inc. has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial, and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois:
- (5) Yardi Systems, Inc. has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) Yardi Systems, Inc. should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Yardi Systems, Inc. is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Yardi Systems, Inc. shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 III. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.


