Exceptions

I am formally filing my exceptions based on the decision rendered on my case. On February 18, 2013 I filed for chapter 7 bankruptcy. This bankruptcy received a discharge, which included an amount owed to PECO. After the discharge, and a new account was established by PECO as this would be considered a new debt. I am asking the honorable Judge Vero to reconsider her decision not to grant a payment arrangement. I am requesting this based on the fact that after my discharge, all debts were extinguished. I unfortunately fell behind again to PECO due to loss of employment. I have now been employed for 2 years and am making a considerable amount salary higher than I have in the past. Although prior arrangements were not kept, I believe those arrangements were prior to my bankruptcy discharge. I am in a new financial situation after the discharge and was not granted a new payment arrangement by the commission post discharge. Please reconsider your decision, allow a payment arrangement for me to bring my account current. I have, since filing my complaint, paid my monthly bill each month and believe that with my new financial situation would be able to keep a new arrangement.
