

**EXCEPTIONS TO FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

NOW comes the Intervenor, Dalton Equity, by and through its
counsel Mey & Sulla, LLP and makes the following Exceptions as follows:

1. On October 14, 2016, PPL Electric filed two Applications seeking
this Commissions approval of the use of eminent domain power for the
purpose of providing electric to a single customer, Williams Pipeline
Company/Transco for an unbuilt, but planned compressor station.

2. On December 14, 2016, the A.L.J. granted Dalton's Petition to
Intervene filed November 23, 2016. Between the A.L.J.'s procedural
Order of December 14, 2016 and April 11, 2017 Intervenor expended
thousands of dollars in preparation for the hearing scheduled April 12th.

Sometime after the procedural Order, but before April 11, 2017, PPL began negotiations with a joining property owner to avoid the use of eminent domain power over Dalton's land without disclosing the same to either the Commission or Dalton as a result of which time, expense and effort were wasted by both the Commission and Dalton.


3. Dalton has always maintained that PPL's Applications were improper under P.U.C. regulations since providing 69 k-v power to Williams Transco was not permitted as a means of public service, accommodation, convenience or safety.

4. Allowing the withdrawal of the Applications without a formal finding, and before the expiration of twenty days from the notice filed by PPL deprives Dalton, and other members of the public of a decision on its merits in this case and future such applications by PPL or other utilities.

WHEREFORE, Dalton Equity, Inc., respectfully requests this Honorable Court to grant its Exceptions and require a finding by the Administrative Law Judge that PPL's Applications were improper under the Public Utility Code.
